#### Leases

After some discussion a new proposal has been made to add under article three sections 10, 11 & 12 which would require a special meeting to bring it to the attention of our homeowners. This special meeting will also include safety neighborhood information given by Lt. Nichols. Tim suggested having the meeting on August 18, 2019. Tim will have the attorney design a legal proxy for those owners that cannot make it to the meeting. Jason Lyons suggested on having the proxies mailed out to the homeowners to ensure they are received.
