Madeleine Award 2024 presented to Jean & Miriam Bourque

Last Sunday, Jean & Miriam were presented with the Diocesan Madeleine Award.

Jean & Miriam moved to Southern Utah in the late 1990's and were founding members of St Paul Catholic Center in Hurricane. They were part of about 12 dedicated Catholics who started gathering at the American Legion Building before our current building was dedicated in 2009.

Even from this small beginning, they were always serving our church and others. It started as Miriam faithfully bringing cookies & treats every week to share after the SCAP service and Jean was always helping - wherever there was a need. Jean regularly helped pick up donations for the Thrift Store when it started in 2007. Small in stature but big in heart; Jean has been known to move furniture twice his size. To this day, I will occasionally get a call from Miriam asking if someone in the church needs a freezer or some furniture.

Jean and Miriam have been married 69 years this past May. They continue to be involved in our church. Jean is a 4th Degree Knight and regularly attends the monthly meetings and helps with selling tickets and the Dixie Direct. He has also supported our church as Cantor, Lector & Maintenance Supervisor in the past. Miriam is still baking treats and involved with our women's group and prayer ministry. Up until last fall, they also faithfully cleaned and conditioned the wooden pews that line our front walkway.

Jean is a master carpenter. As we settled into our church space many years ago - he again, filled the need and created many articles we still use in our sanctuary today. The book stand for the Priest's Missal, the board that displays the hymn numbers, the incense display stand and our poor box are just a few of the items designed and crafted by Jean.

My (Suzie's) favorite discovery of Jean's handiwork happened this past Easter. We transformed a space into our Altar of Repose, and it remained available to parishioners until Midnight. In the late hours of the night, as I sat in front of Jesus in our temporary tabernacle; the matching handiwork stood out to me. I knew this tabernacle was also built by Jean Bourque. I am so glad I was able to get these photos of Jean & Miriam at our Altar of Repose. Thank you for your strong faith, faithfulness in service and love for the members of St Paul's. It is a legacy for each of us to use as a model as we serve Our Lord.

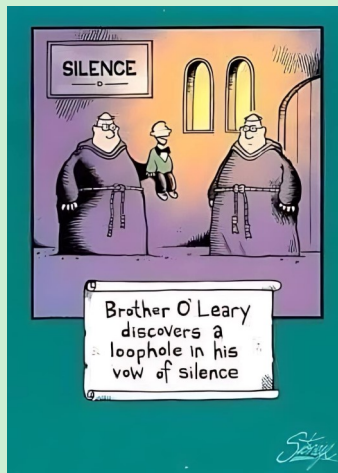
