⁷The first message of warning: And there will be shocking events resulting in judgment with destruction and death. Nations and their leaders will be deceived, causing themselves to be destroyed and the wicked will be destroyed with them.

⁸The second message of warning: And a kingdom showing opposition to God will consume people through violence and cause a great number of people to die separated from God. ⁹And many people who have heard the Gospel will be deceived, they will give up their faith in Jesus and no longer be sustained by God's power. –Revelation 8:7-9
