

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

April 24, 2017

The Jewell County Commissioners met April 24, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Steve Greene, Mark Fleming and Keith Roe present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

Wanda Backstrom, 12th Judicial District Community Corrections, reviewed the FY 2018 KDOC Adult Comprehensive Plan and FY18 Behavioral Health Grant. She also provided the budget summaries. Steve Greene moved that the proper officer's sign the community services grant applications. Keith Roe seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Travis Garst discussed disposal of the pork from the accident on the Highway. He said Republic County recycling is working really well.

Gail Bartley said he had the LEPC meeting on April 12th, the District Weed meeting on April 13th and the Mass Casualty Drill on April 22nd.

Nora Rhoades said the Extension District is in the process of filling the Horticulture and Livestock Agent positions. Nora said the Jewell County Fair is July 16 through 19th with the theme of "Grow with the Green".
