- You must be pre-registered by **Friday September 23rd at 7pm** – or you will not play in the first round. Players not pre-registered will be paired for the second round and will receive a ½ point bye for the first round. Pre-register at www.spacecoastchess.org/
- First round starts at 9:00 am. All players should be on site and checked in by 8:45 am.
- \$20 if pre-registered by Friday September 23rd at 7 PM. \$25 if not pre-registered (walk-ins). Pre- register at www.spacecoastchess.org/
- First time **Brevard County** players are Free- If this is your very first tournament you don't have to pay \$20, however, you must pre-register and purchase a USCF membership.
- USCF membership required- This must be purchased in advance from the USCF- <https://secure2.uschess.org/webstore/member.php>
- Tournament fees will be collected at the tournament site (you cannot pay online). Cash or check. Make entry fee checks payable to Space Coast Scholastic Chess.

There will be Five sections: K-1, K-3, K-6, K-12 , Scholastic Experts & Masters (SEM). All sections play 5 rounds. SE is for players rated from 1000-1399. SM is for players rated between 1400-1800. All games played at G25;d5 (Each player gets 25 minutes w/ 5 second delay) except SEM section games (G40;d5). No elimination. A half point bye may be requested for rounds 1-5 at pre-registration. Latest rating will be used for pairings and prizes.

INDIVIDUAL & TEAM TROPHIES -Trophies to top 5 players in K-1, K-3, K-6, K-12, top under player in K-3, K-6 and K-12, Top 2 in Scholastic Experts and to Top Scholastic Master. Biggest upset trophies in K-3, K-6, and K-12. Plaques to Top teams in K-1, K-12, & Scholastic Experts, Top 3 teams in K-3 and K-6. Medals awarded to first-time players. Top 4 players count for team trophies. Grand Prix trophies awarded after Season Finale trophy ceremony.
