Notice of 21-Day Public Review and Intent to adopt a Sphere of Influence Update and Municipal Service Review for the South County Agencies

Project Summary. A Sphere of Influence (SOI) is defined by Government Code 56425 as "...a plan for the probable physical boundary and service area of a local agency or municipality..." The Sphere of Influence Update and Municipal Service Review for the South County Agencies identify the areas where future annexations might be considered and evaluated. The Agencies included in this Sphere of Influence and Municipal Services Review Update are; the Cities of Arroyo Grande and Grover Beach, Oceano Community Services District, and South San Luis Obispo County Sanitation District. The Municipal Service Reviews evaluate the jurisdiction's capabilities to serve existing and future residents and is the basis for Sphere of Influence decisions. The SOI for the City of Grover Beach, Oceano Community Services District and South San Luis Obispo County Sanitation District will not change from the existing SOI. The Sphere of Influence for the City of Arroyo Grande and is recommended to add a small area near Virginia Drive an existing development of 6 residences.
