Chamber Music Raleigh (CMR), started in 1941 as the Raleigh Chamber Music Guild (RCMG) by a group of 20 local professional musicians, has expanded over its 78 years to become one of the premiere classical music organizations in the Triangle area, presenting both world-class ensembles and musicians from across the state.

Since the late '40s, CMR has offered the world's most distinguished artists and chamber music ensembles in programs comparable to those experienced in the major music capitals here and in Europe. In conjunction with the North Carolina Museum of Art, CMR has for the past 20 years presented a unique approach to concerts by coordinating them with docent tours of related artworks from the Museum's permanent collection and special exhibits. These offerings by North Carolina ensembles enhance visitors' experiences with interdisciplinary approaches to great art and music.

Chamber Music Raleigh also offers many outreach events for Wake County students, master classes for aspiring young musicians, and opportunities for under-served adult populations to hear live classical music.
