



The reason for this message is to remind all of us to continue to place the chlorine tablets in the sand filters in order to disinfect the discharges into our lovely lake.

As summer slips away-this is something that could be overlooked but it is a year-round requirement and certainly worthy of our attention to protect our water supply.

The source of these tablets is as follows and if you have any questions regarding their installation just let me know.
