The Hurlburt Field Thrift Shop is currently accepting resumes from applicants for the **Thrift Shop Assistant Manager** position and for a general position as cashier and store helper. These are part-time positions. Both will have a regular weekly schedule with some variation.

The Thrift Shop Assistant Manager will work an average of 15-20 hours per week with the potential to occasionally work additional hours as needed, 2-4 days per week, to include one weeknight per week (required), one Saturday per month (required). The general position will be similar. Hours will vary from 12-20 hours per week, scheduled weekly.
