The Center remains empty due to state mandates. We miss you dearly, and we are looking forward to the day when you can all return.

As we move forward in this unprecedented/ unpredictable time, decisions must be made to how we can serve you safely following the guidelines.

We will not be having indoor Bingo, choir, chair volleyball or euchre the rest of this year as we are unable to adhere to the guidelines for these activities. We are trying to start up



some small groups that we can social distance with less than 10 people. Check out our new events that are outlined in this newsletter.

We have implemented innovative ways to provide services to you through our community without the risk of face to face contact, and still follow the Ohio Department of Health protocol, such as meal pick-up, weekend food boxes, exercise, and Delay the Disease.

You may have noticed that our Governor has said that Senior Centers/Adult Day Cares can open September 21, we have not received guidelines yet for how this will take place. We have already been continuing services that have been deemed essential and will continue on that path until we receive notice of a full opening. Keep in mind that all high-touch surfaces must be cleaned daily/after use for your safety and ours. Our senior centers will remain open for small groups and essential business until the first of year.

Medical transportation service is operating on a limited basis. All drivers and passengers must submit to temperature checks, system evaluations, and sanitizing measures that have been put in place. Transportation is on a limited capacity and only for **essential medical appointments.**






