Bozeman Figure Skating Club Membership Agreement/Code of Conduct

All applications for membership in the Bozeman Figure Skating Club must be accompanied by a signed Membership Agreement form.

Communications

 Be a responsible member of the Bozeman Figure Skating Club by doing your part to stay informed. The Bozeman Figure Skating Club tries to keep members apprised of upcoming events, ice schedules, etc. primarily through emails, postings, and meetings. The best way for members to keep informed is by checking your emails regularly, the bulletin board at the Haynes Pavilion, the BFSC Barn, joining our Facebook page, attending meetings, and asking questions of the skating director, coaches or other members.

Ice Fees

• Payment for each figure skating session and BFSC classes must be received participating.

Attitude & Sportsmanship Expectations

- Enter the rink with a positive attitude.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Show respect for coaches, skaters, staff and parents.
- Be polite and considerate to other skaters.
- As a member of the Bozeman Figure Skating Club you are representing our Club, particularly when wearing club apparel. Make sure you are conducting yourself in a manner that reflects positively on our Club.

Ice Use Rules

- "Right of Way" occurs in the following order: (1) lessons, (2) skater performing their program with music, (3) higher level skaters, and (4) all others.
- Keep skating flow moving. Standing still or visiting is disruptive and interrupts the flow of traffic.
- "Lutz Corners" are not a place to "hang out". Keep in mind that skaters are jumping in both directions...all four corners are "lutz corners".
- Spins should be done in the center of the ice unless being performed during a program or lesson.
- Working in groups is allowed only if it is productive and not disruptive to other skaters.
- Be aware of others skaters' patterns on the ice.

- Programs -- Each skater may play their music one time by placing it in line with other skaters' music. Coaches have the right of way.
- Talking and socializing should be done before or after ice time...not while on the ice.
- Encouragement from the bleachers is acceptable; Coaching from the bleachers is not acceptable.
- Parents are not allowed in the hockey box during ice time.

Coach Requirements and Expectations

- Attend all BFSC events when possible.
- Have SafeSport/CER/INS/PSA completed and in their folders.

Encourage students to take appropriate classes to save money and support BFSC. Only Bozeman Figure Skating Club members may receive private lessons on club ice.

- Report accidents by filling out an accident report form.
- Return and respect all equipment such as the harness, iPad, and other training tools.

Skater and Parent Expectations

- Emotional outbursts will not be tolerated.
- Coaches and/or Board Members reserve the right to expel a skater from the ice.
- Suggestions or concerns should be directed in writing to the Board.
- Do not disturb a coach during a lesson. Discussions with a coach should occur before or after practice, or a meeting should be arranged off the ice.

Volunteer Opportunities

The Bozeman Figure Skating Club conducts four (4) major fundraising events each year and we count on all families to volunteer at a minimum of one (1) major events each year. (Skate with Santa, Holiday Exhibition, Competition, and the end of the year show)

Volunteers on Sundays for Learn to Skate are encouraged. In addition to our major fundraisers we manage a large Learn to Skate Program that relies on volunteers for registration, skate rental, and monitoring the LTS practice session ice.

Course of Action

Should a parent or member not adhere to the above, the Bozeman Figure Skating Club Board holds the member and/or parent accountable and the Board is empowered to take necessary action. Actions could be as simple as a verbal warning to the parent or member, up to disciplinary hearings before the Board leading to suspension or expulsion from the Bozeman Figure Skating Club.

Implementation

Anyone may file a complaint, in writing and signed, to the President of the Bozeman Figure Skating Club or to the Bozeman Figure Skating Director.

SafeSport Statement for Membership Renewal

The Bozeman Figure Skating Club is committed to creating a safe and positive environment for members' physical, emotional and social development and ensuring that it promotes an environment free of misconduct.

The following code of conduct applies to all participants in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating and the Bozeman Figure Skating Club including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions, training camps and local rink activities.

I recognize that my participation or my child's in all the activities associated with U.S. Figure Skating and the Bozeman Figure Skating Club is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents.

U.S. Figure Skating Member Code of Conduct GR 1.02

I recognize that my participation in all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions and training camps, is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents. As a precondition to participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I will adhere to the following tenets in good faith:

A. I will exhibit the highest standards of fairness, ethical behavior and genuine good sportsmanship in all of my relations with others.

B. I will not damage public or private property. I understand that I may be held financially responsible for damage deemed to be wantonly or willfully executed on my part, and that I may be subject to disciplinary action by U.S. Figure Skating.

C. I will not use or possess illegal drugs, and I will not engage in criminal activity. I understand that, if I am found to use or possess illegal drugs, or if I am found to engage in any criminal activity during any activity hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I may be subject to criminal penalties as well as penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating. D. I will adhere to the rules of U.S. Figure Skating and the host organization at all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

E. I will comply with all applicable anti-doping rules including, but not limited to, ISU and USADA anti-doping rules.

F. I will conduct myself in a manner not detrimental to the welfare of figure skating. I understand that my actions reflect on U.S. Figure Skating and the sport of figure skating both positively and negatively. I understand that if my acts, statements, or conduct are considered detrimental to the welfare of figure skating by the appropriate authority, I may be subject to penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating pursuant to GR 1.04.

G. I understand that the penalties that may be imposed may include, but are not limited to, loss of future international selections, loss of financial support from U.S. Figure Skating and its

Memorial Fund, and loss of participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

H. I understand that all disciplinary proceedings will be conducted pursuant to Article XXV, Section 3, of the U.S. Figure Skating bylaws, and that my rights and remedies are derived therefrom.

I have read and agree to abide by the Code of Conduct. I hereby apply for membership in the Bozeman Figure Skating Club, For and in consideration of the acceptance by BFSC of my application for membership, I hereby waive any right to claim damages against the Club, its officers, directors, and members, and release any and all of them from any liability, which may arise out of my membership therein. On July 1, 2013, U.S. Figure Skating implemented the Safe Sport program, which seeks to ensure that its members can participate in figure skating in a safe and harassment free environment.
