CHAIR'S CORNER

As I write this Chair's Corner, I just finished my first day of Kimball's annual ESD re-certification audit. During our original certification audit, we were given an opportunity for improvement with grounding a manual scoring machine which cuts PCBA panels. After many months, we were able to work with our maintenance team and successfully ground the scoring machine. The ESD Plant Auditor and Technician went out and tested the machine with a surface resistance meter and confirmed it was grounded.

During the audit today, we brought the auditor over to the machine to show him how we accomplished the grounding. When we approached the machine, we noticed that the way it was grounded had changed. We tested both sides and found out one side was grounded and the other side was not. Whoever changed the grounding connection did not test it to make sure it was grounded. Luckily we just received another opportunity for improvement and not a minor finding. This makes me wonder how to control something like this in the future and make sure items get tested when adjustments are made. This is real important to ensure a good quality system. How many of us had the same experience with something similar. When adjustments are made to machines or testing devices, do we ensure that the resulting outputs are conforming?

As a reminder, we will be voting on next year's Leadership Team members at the October meeting. Please make every effort to attend in order to make sure your voice is heard.

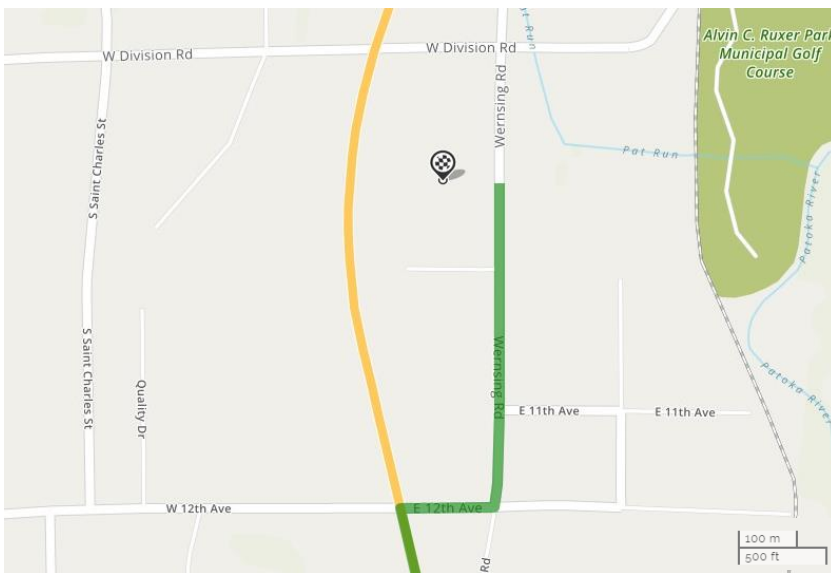
