

Basic Blouse Class

Required items:

- Notepaper/pen
- 2 to 2 ½ yards of fashion fabric appropriate for making a dress shirt (crisp, firm fabrics such as cotton or linen broadcloth or pique, silks like duppioni or taffeta, or blends of such fibers). Pre-wash and dry your fabric in the manner you will launder it once it's a garment. Refer to your body measurements and chart from McCall's 6750 for exact yardage required.
- Matching high-quality polyester thread
- 1 yard of high-quality, light to mid-weight, woven fusible interfacing (available for purchase at sewBoise if desired)
- ½" buttons – 6 for ¾ length sleeves, 8 for long sleeved

Provided items:

- ✓ Pattern M6750

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Scissors and/or rotary cutter
- Glass or metal head Pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Tape Measure
- Hem gauge
- Small see-through ruler (approx 2"x 18" and flexible)
- Larger ruler (approx 6" x 24")
- Hand sewing needles
- Bees' wax or Thread Heaven
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Tailor's chalk or other marking tool(s)
- Supply bin/tote
- Sewing machine
