We are all very experienced in caring for and teaching children.

I have my Early Childhood Education Degree. Carrie has an A.A.S. Linda recently renewed her CDA which is comparable to a 2 year early childhood education degree. Marsha has been working with children for many many years. Although I only need one assistant working with me, I have Linda and Marsha as extra hands and back up so I can always be dependable for parents. During the day, we run a preschool program from September thru May. Summers are for swimming and lots of outside time. We also do stories and songs with the toddlers with little activities and always reading and singing to the infants. Infants are also worked with learning games to help them develop.
