First Lesson Genesis 47:1-12 1 Then Joseph went and told Pharaoh, and said, "My father and my brothers, their flocks and their herds and all that they possess, have come from the land of Canaan; and indeed they are in the land of Goshen." 2 And he took five men from among his brothers and presented them to Pharaoh. 3 Then Pharaoh said to his brothers, "What is your occupation?" And they said to Pharaoh, "Your servants are shepherds, both we and also our fathers." <u>4</u> And they said to Pharaoh, "We have come to dwell in the land, because your servants have no pasture for their flocks, for the famine is severe in the land of Canaan. Now therefore, please let your servants dwell in the land of Goshen."5 Then Pharaoh spoke to Joseph, saving, "Your father and your brothers have come to you.6 The land of Egypt is before you. Have your father and brothers dwell in the best of the land; let them dwell in the land of Goshen. And if you know any competent men among them, then make them chief herdsmen over my livestock."7 Then Joseph brought in his father Jacob and set him before Pharaoh; and Jacob blessed Pharaoh.8 Pharaoh said to Jacob, "How old are you?"9 And Jacob said to Pharaoh, "The days of the years of my pilgrimage are one hundred and thirty years; few and evil have been the days of the years of my life, and they have not attained to the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their pilgrimage."10 So Jacob blessed Pharaoh, and went out from before Pharaoh. 11 And Joseph situated his father and his brothers, and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, in the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had commanded.12 Then Joseph provided his father, his brothers, and all his father's household with bread, according to the number in their families.

<u>Second Lesson</u> 1 Timothy 2:1-7 <u>1</u> Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, <u>2</u> for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.<u>3</u> For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior,<u>4</u> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.<u>5</u> For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,<u>6</u> who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time, <u>7</u> for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle--I am speaking the truth in Christ and not lying--a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

**Gospel** Matthew 28:16-20 <u>16</u> Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them.<u>17</u> When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted.<u>18</u> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.<u>19</u> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,<u>20</u> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.


