Town of West Jefferson - Board of Aldermen Special Meeting Minutes May 2, 2018 | 5:30 p.m.

At 5:30 p.m. Mayor Baldwin called to order the special meeting of the Board of Aldermen.

<u>Presentation of Budget – Fiscal Year 2018-19</u> – Brantley Price, Town Manager, presented the FY 18-19 budget, along with the budget message to the board. The property tax rate will remain the same as FY 2017-18 at \$.42/\$100 in valuation as well as the Schedule of Fees. Brantley then highlighted the following items in each fund:

General Fund Revenues:

- Property Tax Revenue Increase Due to GE Expansion Projections
- CDBG Downtown Redevelopment Fund \$349,410
- Local option sales tax 3% increase
- Utility franchise tax Flat
- Fund Balance \$16,000
- Interest Income Higher invested in CD at Lifestore with higher return

General Fund Expense – Highlights:

- Health Insurance 7% decrease
- 3% Salary increase across the board totals \$25,907 including benefits. If the savings from the reduction in health insurance cost is deducted then the 3% increase will only cost the Town \$15,880

 - o \$31,717 Cemetery
 - \$4,800 Park Entrance

<u>Closed Session per G.S. 143.318.11(a) (6) to Discuss Personnel</u> – Alderman Green asked for the Board to enter into closed session per G.S. 143.318.11(a) (6). The Board would return to open session following closed session, and any items in need of a vote would be addressed. Alderman Green made the motion to enter into closed session, seconded by Alderman Reeves. The vote of 4-0 in favor. The time was 6:08 pm.

The Board returned to open session at 6:40 pm. Mayor Baldwin stated the Board was in agreed to a 3% raise for all employees. Other changes to the budget include the removal of the second police car and a reduction in the fund balance.

A public hearing will be held at the regular Aldermen meeting on Monday, June 4, 2018 at West Jefferson Town Hall at 6:00 pm for anyone wishing to comment on the proposed budget for FY 2018-19. Following the public hearing, the FY 2018-19 Budget Ordinance will be considered by the Board.

<u>Adjournment-</u> With nothing further, Alderman Shoemaker made the motion to adjourn the special meeting. Alderman Reeves seconded with a unanimous vote in favor. The time was 6:49 pm.
