Membership

While men's clubs are struggling all over the country, El Prado Men's Club seems to be holding its own. Our membership currently stands at 142 members. This number includes 16 new members and 126 renewed.

There are some changes with regard to membership of which everyone should be aware. First, the club is no longer offering a prorated membership fee. This means that anyone who joins at anytime during the year will still need to pay the \$140 fee. This change is driven by changes by SCGA which is moving to a rolling 12 month activation period. Beginning in March, whenever a person joins, they will get a 12 month window of active SCGA handicap and benefits.

Keep in mind that you can recruit a new member at any time and that new member will receive a \$25 gift card at El Prado as well as a free round of golf in either the Tuesday (green fee and cart) or Saturday (green fee) skins game. That's up to a \$64 value. Considering that they will also get a SCGA handicap, a \$36 cost, they are getting all the privileges of membership for \$40. Your efforts in recruiting will also be rewarded with a similar round of golf.

If your recruit uses the SCGA portal to join, be sure to let him know that once he gets a welcoming e-mail from me, to e-mail me back identifying who recruited him. If he joins directly through the club, there is a place on the membership form to identify the recruiter.

Also, don't forget that Associate Members are invited to play in our Skins games during the month of February. If you see a new face, be sure to introduce yourself and let them know about the benefits of full membership.

Our next tournament is the President's cup on February 25th. We moved this tourney late in the month to accommodate team play. The format is individual low net, with regular payouts, skins, and closests in 4 flights.

In addition, this tournament determines the qualifiers and seeding for our annual match play event, the President's Cup. After the tournament, the top 16 in each flight qualify for this single elimination event, with weekly matches for several weeks. The 2016 President's Cup Champion John Agan is the #1 seed in his flight and will not have to qualify.

If you cannot participate in all the match play, you can still play the monthly tournament, and just forfeit your first round match.

A memorial service will be held at 11 AM on February 11 at Community




Presbyterian Church in Lake Havasu, AZ with luncheon reception to follow at London Bridge Resort.

Prominent Local Golf Reporter Phil Roche Passes Away



Long time golf reporter Southern for the California News Group. Phil passed Roche away on January 17. Roche covered parts of Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties in his "Tee to Green" column and regularly reported on El Prado Men's Club tournament results. player accomplishments and

special events through the SCNG and appearing in the Inland Valley Daily Bulletin and the Progress Bulletin.

Phil was a great promoter of the game of golf and used his weekly column to foster its growth and sing its praises. In addition to covering tournaments he also gave great attention to other club activities and associated events including the El Prado Junior Golf the Program. Josie Cordero Memorial Golf Tournament and the Chino Amateur Golf Championship.

Phil was a pretty decent golfer but always self-effacing. Yet he was never short on words when he sang the praises of our current and former members such as Allen Belknap, Billy Mouw, Eric Fekin, Pete Waasdorp, and Terry Hove. His words were always kind, clever and generous. If your name appeared in one of his columns you felt like you were ready for the tour.

Phil's column ran for years until he gave it up in 2012. His son, Pat, is a former amateur member of our club as well as a professional instructor.

Phil also founded the Inland Valley Amateur Championship decades ago and it now bears his name.

At the time of printing, services had not been scheduled.
