

8. Dining Room: (a) Jordan is no longer our Executive Chef. A temporary chef from Corp. will take his place. We eagerly await Darrell's return sometime soon. (b) A salary adjustment is being made for our kitchen staff and servers. (c) Residents are reminded to please stay away from the kitchen door, asking for items their server will bring when you sit in your seat. A supervisor is needed to enforce. (d) Residents would like eggs benedict for breakfast, not dinner. (e) Residents want the promised waffle bar and omelet bar. (f) Lemons: Michael reported the cost of lemons was too high. We suggested cutting back by putting slices in a bowl on the Papaya cart, and asking if someone wanted a lemon with their Papaya. That suggestion not yet implemented. (g) Now that the unused table in the center of the DR has been removed, the tables need to be re-aligned as before – allowing server carts and resident walkers to safely get by.
