

Outdoor Blast 2019

Behavior Agreement for Girls Attending



Outdoor Blast is an outdoor learning event where girls and adults will together learn from experienced outdoor trainers, improve outdoor skills, make new friends, develop social skills, and enjoy a day at Camp Meriwether.

As such, we must follow some strict procedures for Check-In and Check-Out:

- All girls attending the event must arrive at the Check-In location between 7:30 and 8:15 AM on Saturday March 30, 2019 with their parent/guardian or the adult on their signed permission form. The adult accompanying the girl must check the girl in and initial an enrollment document. The Check-In station is at the Daisy Den Shelter. Please refer to the Outdoor Blast website for directions.
- The girl should have turned in or should bring with her the following documents:
 1. The Safety/Behavior Expectation Agreement completed and reviewed by her and her parent/guardian and signed by both.
 2. A completed Outdoor Blast Permission form with important contact information – cell or contact phone number is critical. We must be able to reach someone in case of emergency during the girl's stay on camp.
 3. A completed GSGATL Girl/Adult Health History Form.
- Any prescribed medications that need to be administered during the event must be given to the Event First Aider (in their original container) at time of Check-In and will be administered as directed. If a girl must carry an epi-pen, inhaler, or other medical device, it too must be documented at Check-In.
- Girls are asked not to bring electronic devices to camp. If they do bring a cell phone, it should be turned off except during lunch or in case of an emergency. For help, they should call the cell number of the primary contact/point-person listed on the back of their name tag.
- The girls must have a buddy if they leave the classroom area.
- For questions before camp, please call Kim Fearnow (678)637-6955 or Melanie Jackson (404)547-6412. While at Camp Meriwether, cell service is spotty and Kim Fearnow is the only one that gets service.
- At the end of the day, each girl must be checked-out by their parent/guardian or the adult on the signed permission form. The adult will be asked to initial a sign-out document.
- All girls must be picked-up as soon as their schedule permits and before 6:30 PM.

As a Girl Scout, it is important to live by the Girl Scout Promise and the Girl Scout Law so the girls agree to:

- Follow all camp rules.
- Respect the authority of Outdoor Blast staff and instructors and follow their directions.
- Leave all electronic devices at home. If they bring a cell phone, they will keep it turned off except during lunch time, breaks, and at the end of the event while awaiting their ride. They may use it to call their emergency contact on the back of their name tag.
- Use appropriate language and behavior and to stay focused on class content.
- Respect other girl and adult classmates and to fully participate in the class activities to the best of their ability.
- Respect all property both man-made and natural resources.
- Help other campers and staff keep the units and camp clean.
- Have fun, try new things, make new friends, and enjoy their camp experience in the spirit of Girl Scouting.
- Stay Found – use the buddy system when traveling between classes and camp activities. (Note: You must be able to walk as no transportation is provided on camp.)

I _____ understand that failure to comply with these expectations will result in a required immediate pickup by a parent/guardian and my not being able to enjoy all the opportunities this event has to offer. In addition, no refund will be issued for missed event opportunities due to a violation of this agreement.
