
ORDER ON RECEIVER'S TENTH MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF SETTLEMENTS WITH THIRD-PARTY DEFENDANT/LICENSEES

On the 8 day of January, 2014, the Court heard the Receiver's Ninth Motion for Approval of Settlements with Third-Party Defendant Licensees Jose (Joe) Fernandez ("Defendant"). The Receiver and Defendant Fernandez entered into a settlement and both parties have signed off on the settlement. The Court, having considered the motion, is of the opinion that the motion should be GRANTED.

It is therefore, ORDERED that the Receiver's settlement with Defendant Jose (Joe) Fernandez is approved as are the legal fees and expenses associated with the settlement.

It is further ORDERED that the claims of Retirement Value brought by the Receiver against Defendant Jose (Joe) Fernandez will be dismissed with prejudice and the judgment against Judgment Debtors Fernandez shall be released. The dismissal is contingent on the payment(s) of funds promised in the settlement agreement.
