



REFLECTIONS




As I read the Gospel this week, I began to reflect on the question: What kind of people was the King consorting with who were so low that they would not even come to his son’s wedding and rejoice with him and his family during this happy occasion? This lead me to the thinking about how important it is for us to choose wisely when we are inviting people to be a part of our lives. The people you invite into your life should be trustworthy, honorable people who have your best interest at heart. They should be people who would go out of their way to ensure that you are safe, happy, and well taken care of. Any other kind of people should be left out of your life.

If the people invited by the king were truly worthy to attend his son’s wedding, they would have come running to help celebrate such a happy occasion. Instead, “Some ignored the invitation and went away, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, mistreated them, and killed them.” Mt. 22:5-6 Wow, they sound like terrible people. So I say to you, choose wisely when you invite people into your life because you certainly do not want to end up like the king who had to resort to inviting strangers to his son’s wedding because he chose people who did not really care for him or his family.
