PAYING YOUR PROPERTY TAXES

TAXES are DUE by Monday, November 7TH, 2022

Postmarks are NOT accepted

After 5:00 p.m. local time on November 7th, 2021, an 8% penalty and 1% monthly interest will be applied to any balance still unpaid.

After three months, the monthly interest will increase to 1.5% on any balance still unpaid.

You can pay your property taxes by:

- **CHECK or MONEY ORDER** – Made payable to the **Town of Coventry**.
 - Mail to: PO Box 8, Coventry, VT 05825 (please allow plenty of time for the mail)
 - Drop off at: The Community Center, 168 Main Street, Coventry VT 05825
 - There is a 24-hour drop box at the handrail next to the entry stairs
 - Town Offices are generally open Monday thru Friday 9am – 3pm
 - The Treasurer's office will be open on Saturday, Nov 5 from 9am – 1pm
