What is a 5-Day Club[®]?



It is a mini-VBS coming to your location! Similar to after-school Good News Clubs, 5-Day Clubs meet for five consecutive days during the summer, one hour each day. Children ages 5-12 years old gather to hear Bible stories, sing songs, learn Bible verses, listen to a missionary story, and play games. During this summer the theme will be *"Turned Around"* – five lessons from the Bible:

- Zacchaeus (Memory Verse: Luke 19:10)
- Mephibosheth (*Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8*)
- Noah's Special Job (Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8-9)
- Saul Trusted Jesus as his Savior (Memory Verse: Romans 5:8)
- Ethiopian Treasurer (Memory Verse: Romans 5:8)

Who Does the Teaching?

High-school and college-age youth are prepared in a two-week training program. Three or more youth will come to conduct each club. They are overseen by Christian adults who have received comparable training. All workers have had a national background check and are approved for children's work.
