2017 JLGA GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION FOR SHOWS 1 - 6

Updated 03-07-17

The following general information applies to all of the 2017 JLGA first six shows of the season. If there is show information specific to each show, that will be noted in the show post on our Facebook page.

Please remember to read ALL JLGA Rules, Guidelines, and Regulations including Bayou Certified Rules. There are some changes for the 2017 JLGA Show Season. Upon paying membership and show fees all JLGA Parents and their youth are agreeing to abide by all JLGA Rules and Guidelines.

Pre-registration

Don't forget to pre-register. It cuts your wait time in line, save on late fees, and helps get the show started on time.

If you are having problems with pre-registration, please message Cynthia Hailey Or Cindy Kay via private message on Facebook for assistance.

For the 2018 Show Season we are now going to have **2** methods of payment for show entries. You can still pay by either cash or check at time of check-in on show day or you can pay on-line prior to the show. On-line payments are going to be on a trial basis this year. This is new to us, so we may have some changes

along the way. However we feel this will open up more opportunities to have on-line auctions, sales, and also to help with check-in at shows.

If you are interested in paying on-line, please keep the following in mind:

1. On-line payments through the bank will be an additional \$1.00 charge per transaction.
2. Credit card charges are 3.5% plus .50 charge per transaction.
3. These payments will be processed through Intuit Quick Books by current JLGA Treasurer Cindy Kay.
4. If you are planning to do on-line payments you must do so when you pre-register no later than 10p on the Monday before the show on Saturday.
5. If you have any questions on this method of payment, please message current JLGA Treasurer Cindy Kay via private message on Facebook.

Deadline for Pre-registration for 2017 will be no later than 10pm on the Wednesday before Saturday's show, unless otherwise noted. **(ADDED 01/2018)**

Remember if you plan to pay on-line, you MUST pre-register no later than 10pm on the Monday before Saturday's show. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Fees for pre-registrations received AFTER Monday before the show on Saturday, must be paid in either cash or check day of show.

Late fees will apply to registrations received after the Wednesday deadline or day of show registrations. Please note there are no late fees for day of show changes to Pre-registrations received before the deadline.

Late fees are \$2 per entry including showmanship.

Arrival Times

Goats may arrive no earlier than 5 pm on the Friday before Saturday's show. Please remember to tighten up as much as possible. Please no tack in pens unless there are also goats in the pens. Please be sure to keep walkways and traffic areas free of show supplies.

Unless otherwise stated, you must bring your own shavings.

Show Check-in

Check-in & Weigh in will be on Show Day morning from 8am - 9am.
Shows start at 10am

Remember to bring your registrations papers and a copy to be kept on file for this year. Also please remember Commercial Does MUST be tattooed COM in one ear and DOE in the other. If you need assistance tattooing your goats, please make sure you arrive at least one hour prior to check-in and ask for this assistance at the scales or the registration desk.

New this year, there will be **2** check-in places. Check-in A will be for any pre-registrations that have **NO** changes. Check-in B will be for Pre-registrations with any needed changes and day of show registrations. **(ADDED 11/11/17) Please remember we no longer have late check-in.** All exhibitors and/or their Parents **MUST** check-in at the designation check-in time day of show. **The only exception is in case of unforeseen circumstance day of show.**

The only exceptions for late check-in are as follows: (ADDED 11/11/17)

- 1. Day of Show ~** If a situation presents that will delay arrival during specified Check-in times, exhibitor's parents and/or family are to contact one of the JLGA Board Members to make them aware of the situation and the fact they will be late. They then will be allowed to check-in when they arrive at the showgrounds. No classes will be held for late arrivals.
- 2. In the event of a conflicting youth activity ~** In the event a youth has

a conflicting event on the same day as a JLGA show and they would like to attend both events, then may request a late check-in at the JLGA show. However the following must be met in order for the late check-in to be granted:

- A. Conflicting events may include other livestock shows or events, ball games, or other school related activities that the youth may wish to be involved in on the same day.
- B. Request for this late check-in **must** be made **at least 2 weeks** in advance of the show and proof of the conflicting activity **must** be sent to the current JLGA Adult Secretary, such as show internet ad, or copy of registration in the other event. Burden of proof lies with the youth's parent asking for the late check-in.
- C. After request is granted, parent must pre-register their youth and pay on-line no later than the Monday before the show on Saturday. There **must** be no changes day of show and no refunds will be given. A credit for a future show may be given IF unforeseen circumstances arise, such as first event going longer than stated or an emergency situation arises that prevent youth from making it to the JLGA show in time for their classes.
