A note from Pastor Fran:

Brenda Hendricks wrote a devotion about leadership:

"Throughout nature we find valuable power structures. Elephant herds have dominant females to guide them to water and food. Geese take turns navigating the flock over hundreds of miles to their winter destinations. Ants march to the cadence of a commander to defend their domain. And lemmings follow their pack leaders without hesitation over cliffs of death.

Nonetheless, not all creatures share the instinct to "elect" a leader. Sheep...for example...seem to wander aimlessly over a pasture, gnawing at the grass until the ground lies bare. None of the sheep take the initiative to climb the next hill to find a fresh meadow for grazing. Therefore, they need shepherds to guide them.

Although human beings understand the necessity of hierarchy, the Bible compares us to sheep. Unable to decipher the best way for ourselves, we often mindlessly follow questionable leadership. Therefore, wrong is strong, complacency rules, and justice is perverted.

Unlike sheep, however, we have a choice. We can turn from our "earthly shepherds" and follow Jesus, the good shepherd."

We are in the process of seeking a leader for the congregation here at The Lutheran Church of the Holy Trinity – following the guidance of Jesus, the good shepherd.

Your Council has finished preparing the Church Profile for submission to the Lutheran Synod, and is working now to establish a Call Committee.

It will be the responsibility of the Call Committee to determine the scope of ministry to be assigned to the new pastor, benefits to be offered to the applicant, and interviewing the applicants who are available.

I ask that you prayerfully consider whether the Holy Spirit might be calling you to be a part of the team that will move us forward to finding a pastoral leader for the congregation here at LCHT.

June 18 - 3rd Sunday after Pentecost, Worship/Holy Communion if pastor available, Father's Day



#### **REDNER'S REGISTER TAPES**

Redner's Warehouse Markets gives 1% of purchases back to the Women of the ELCA. This one percent can really add up! And the monies go to good things like the Mission Trip, VFW, Berk's Women in Crisis, just to name a few.

In order for Redner's to count the receipt (a.k.a. - register tape), it has to be the ENTIRE receipt, and it has to have a "save-a-tape" number on it.

Use your pump perks card or save-a-tape card at the checkout. Then, just drop the ENTIRE receipt in the box at the ushers station in the narthex.

DO NOT cut the bottom off. We only get credit for COMPLETE tapes! Also, please be sure to turn your tapes in in a timely manner, as Redner's will not accept any over three years old. Your help is so appreciated. If you have any questions, please see Janet Kleffel.
