Awards --> Individual class awards will be presented on the beach, immediately after each classes second round of racing. Please come to the podium blocks and congratulate the winners.

- RACE COURSE, PROCEDURES and REMINDERS

 ⇒ The Circle Race Course will be approximately 2 mile laps with the start at the closed end of lake (in front of the beach).
- ⇒ No skiing to the start line, with the exception of the open classes. First time by the finish line counts as a lap.
- ⇒ There will be 2 Rounds for each class over the course of the weekend. All skiers must complete all the laps in round 1. Race officials may choose to flag in finishers in the second round if overall placing is not impacted.
- ⇒ Any class with less than 3 entries may be combined and run with another class. Every effort will be made to avoid boat/observer conflicts when combining. With this in mind, the race schedule may be modified.
- ⇒ Pole Positions will be drawn for Round 1, then flip flopped for Round 2.
- ⇒ Points will determine the overall winners. In the event of a tie, total time will be used as the tiebreaker.
- ⇒ Random *boat inspections* will be conducted.
- ⇒ V-drive boat owners must submit a rudder certification completed no more than 30 days prior to the event.
- ⇒ <u>Patrol Assistance Needed</u> anyone available to assist with patrol duties (bring your own boat), we will offer lunch (per day) and a tshirt (if working all day). Help needed both days.

CLASS NOTES

<u>DOUBLE-UP RACE</u> → If you team is mixed (1 male, 1 female) then you must have a skier combined age 50 or less or 100+. Same teams (2 men or 2 women) must have a skier combined age 30 or less or 100+ (age as of 9/29/18). This is one race. Open to all skiers. (non National class)

SOCIAL OPEN → Anyone can ski this class. Must be on social ski per rule book, 100' rope and hands out front, but no skier class restrictions.

<u>STOCK BOATS</u> → Make sure your boats are legal. Must be "stock" (no alternations / modifications to factory installed carburation, fuel injection, intake/ exhaust manifolds, outdrives, lower units, etc. Max speed 75 MPH. **Must have a back seat**, engine cover, full carpeting and upholstery with seating for 4. (full rules online at www.nwsra.net)

<u>OUTBOARDS</u> → This will be one race (men and women combined). If there is enough participation to justify splitting the class on race day, it will be re-evaluated.

DISK RACE (if enough interest) → 1 Lap, bring your own disk! Open to all skiers. (non National class)

<u>PEE-WEE RACE</u> (if enough interest) → One straight away. Trainer skis, with an adult, etc. Bring your own equipment! Must be age 12 or younger and cannot have ever skied in another NWSRA class. (non National class).

Classes marked as "non National class" will not receive points or National Champion titles
