Parents who construct positive personality traits of their children and teachers who educate and illuminate can be the best mentors.

Share with us any one of your inventions and the period of the invention.

I invented Gyroscope in the year 1974 that measures angular twist and speed.

Have you ever felt work pressure? If so, during what times?

Abdul Kalam used to insist on the best quality of the products to be used in his projects within a stipulated time else he will be inclining to purchase the same from other sources. The pressure that increased my passion of getting my products to be used in his projects has driven me to come out with a quality work.

Have you faced any failure during Rocket launch?

Yes, in 2002, we faced a failure in rocket launch due to workmanship defect.

I have worked with Dr. Abdul Kalam for 18 years and got benefited with his guidance, support, motivation and encouragement. From 1988-2015, he has rendered his guidance and support at the times of need.

Helping hands for Visually Challenged people

Electrical Components used:

Micro SD card, Amplifier, Battery 4.5 volts, Speaker, Input device board, solar Panel and Wires.

Procedure:

- * Connect the input device board with battery (4.5 V) using wires.
- * Connect the battery to the Solar panel which is used to recharge the battery in day time.
- * The whole device works in dual power: Solar power and Battery power. Connect the input device to the output device (Amplifier) and a small speaker which acts as an output system.
- * Record the voice "PLEASE HELP ME FRIENDS" in the micro SD Card and fix in the device. Connect a small switch on the top of the device. Create a circuit diagram and attach it along with this project.
- * Fix the whole set-up with walking stick and offer to a visually Challenged person.

Observation:

When the switch gets ON we can hear the voice "PLEASE HELP ME FRIENDS" from the device.

We offered this device to the visually challenged people. They felt very happy to hear the voice. They thanked us and also appreciated us for our work and said that this device would surely help them in their day to day life. We found that after hearing the voice "PLEASE HELP ME FRIENDS", the public closer by came forward and whole heartedly helped the visually challenged people.

Making of Hydraulic Crane

Materials required:

Foam sheet, small sticks, glue, syringe, 100 ml syringe (2), some rubber tubing and vegetable oil.

Procedure:

- * Fill the syringes half full with vegetable oil.
- * Attach the tubing. Insert the nozzle of another syringe into the end of the rubber tubing.

Observation:

When the syringe with vegetable oil is pressed the pressure increases and gets released through the rubber tubing and moves the cardboard attached to the other syringe. The induced Hydraulic pressure results in the movement of the attached object.

This Hydraulic crane is used to dig and lift the heavy objects.
