Co-founder of City Mouse, Billy Steiner has led this band since 1971 in performances from nightclubs and colleges to honky-tonks to weddings, christenings and funerals, to singing the National Anthem at a couple of Minnesota Timberwolves' basketball games. City Mouse has developed a unique bond with the Mankato Symphony and together they have performed before thousands of appreciative listeners at "Rockin' In the Quarry". Winner of the prestigious Minnesota Music Award for Harmonica in 1989, Steiner harmonica can be heard on many radio and TV commercials and sound tracks as well as recording projects with a variety of musical artists. He is also a member of the Lost Walleyes Orchestra, a smaller off-shoot of City Mouse.
