

## 2019 DRIFTING INFORMATION

## **PIT AREA**

- No car entry fee
- Drivers are \$55
- Non-Drivers are \$10
- Minors (those under 18) that enter onto the racing surface in a car must have a birth certificate on file and must either have a parent/legal court appointed guardian with them or have on file notarized parental consent paperwork
- Everyone entering the pit area must sign the release form
- The regular race night grandstand area will not be open for these events, there is a grandstand in the pit area

## **EVENT GUIDELINES**

- Conduct details can be found in the Speedrome Rules of Competition
- Participants must always wear a helmet and use seatbelts while on the track
- Daytime events will begin at 12pm (tandems from 2pm to 4pm)
- Evening events will begin at 5pm (tandems from 7pm to 9pm)
- Common sense rules apply to drifting vehicles with safety as the top priority such as batteries strapped down, convertibles must have roll bars, etc
- The Speedrome has the right to remove vehicles from participation with safety in mind. Vehicles with dragging parts, leaking any fluids, or flat tires must immediately slow and leave the track to be repaired
- The Speedrome has the right to remove any driver from participation due to bad conduct or malicious driving on the property
