## Tournament News

Golf in December always draws a crowd, especially with a fun format. This month we had 109 players tee it up with 4 clubs on the red tees. How did it feel to have those low handicaps?

44 players took home a share of the \$4,311 purse. The Top 25 list has some familiar names near the top, as well as some new members inching up the board. After just three tournaments, 27 players have already won enough to cover their membership dues!

We had very few adjustments to signups or tee times, so thanks to everyone for sending your signups to Doug on time, and checking the tournament roster when it comes out. Requests are still a challenge, but we are trying. Occasionally we miss one (sorry!), but we hope you understand that when you request LATE, and the players working the check in table have to go last, you may be several groups before the last time.

We tried a "personalized" email to let you know your flight, course, and tee time before the tournament, and several of sent a response thanking us, so we'll look at continuing that practice.

The 2022 Tournament Schedule is published on the web site, and also in this newsletter. The dates and formats set, so you can mark your calendar now. Note that we have gone back to a single weekend for the Club Championship. Net flights will play Saturday and Sunday. Gross champion candidates, as well as senior candidates for the SCGA TOCC will also play on the Friday before. We are still nailing down the details for minimum participation to play in the club championship, but we should have those worked out in plenty of time.

January will be a 2 Man Better Ball tournament. There is an stroke maximum difference in course handicaps between partners. You can pick your own partner, or sign up as a single and we'll try to pair you with a good partner.

Signups for a guaranteed spot in the tournament close Saturday January 8, or Tuesday January 11 if we have room. Signup by emailing Doug at [dbenc@ap.org](mailto:dbenc@ap.org). We will publish the roster of
