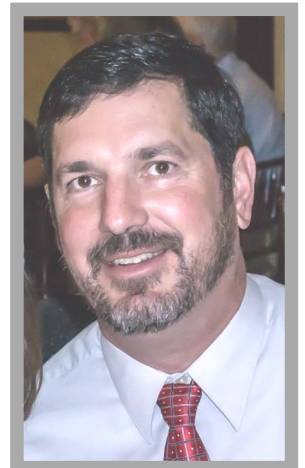
FROM THE PRESIDENT
