RESOLUTION NO. 16-48

**ASSIGNING DUTIES FOR THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT PROCESS TO THE
TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR**

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio met in regular session on the 7th day of June 2016, at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Offices located at One Business Park Drive, with the following members present:

Trustee Johnson moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The Ohio Revised Code Section 505.032 provides that:

The Township Administrator shall under the direction of the Board of Trustees:

(G) Perform such additional duties as the Board may determine by resolution.

The Board of Trustees may assign to such Township Administrator any office, position, or duties under its control; such office, position and duties to be performed under the direction of the Board and be in addition to those set forth in this section; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87 provides that:

(A) A Board of Trustees may provide for the abatement, control or removal of vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris from land in the township, if the Board determines that the owner's maintenance of that vegetation, garbage and refuse, or other debris constitutes a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees to create a more efficient and timely process for determining and abating nuisances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

Section 1. That this Board of Township Trustees, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code 505.032 hereby assigns to the Jefferson Township Administrator all duties associated with the Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87. Notwithstanding this, the Board of Trustees does not assign the duty to hold a hearing, should the landowner object to the abatement, control, or removal of vegetation, garbage, refuse and other debris. Such a hearing, if requested by the land owner, shall be held before the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees.

Section 2. The Township Administrator is authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to implement this resolution.
