





The Board believes that a National Model A Meet is NOT in the best interest of the Twin Cities Model A Ford Club as an organization, and NOT in the best interest of its membership, and therefore the TCMAFC will NOT be hosting a National Meet in the near future at this time.

Although the winter has been long, the Board has spent hundreds of hours of their time this winter researching and discussing major decisions regarding the direction and the future of your club. It is the Board's desire to do what is in the best interest of the club and membership as a whole, and I believe the directions taken this month are in the best interest of the club and its membership, and just as it is inevitable that change will happen, I am certain that in the coming weeks the direction of the weather will change in our favor for tours and meets. Enjoy your piece of living history, your club is in good hands.


