- \rightarrow Rating Descriptions
 - ightarrow 1.0: New and have only minimal knowledge of the game and the rules.
 - → 1.5: Limited to some rallies. Learning how to serve. Developing a forehand. Fails to return easy balls frequently and occasionally misses the ball entirely. Played a few games and is learning the court lines, scoring, and some basic rules of the game.
 - → 2.0: Sustains a short rally with players of equal ability. Demonstrating the basic shot strokes forehand, backhand, volley, overhead and the serve, but has obvious weaknesses in most strokes. Familiar with court positioning in doubles play.
 - → 2.5: Makes longer lasting slow-paced rallies. Makes most easy volleys and uses some backhands, but needs more work on developing shot strokes. Beginning to approach the non-volley zone to hit volleys. Aware of the soft game. Knowledge of the rules has improved. Court coverage is weak but improving.
 - → 3.0: More consistent on the serve and service return and when returning medium-paced balls. Demonstrates improved skills with all the basic shot strokes and shot placement but lacks control when trying for direction, depth, or power on their shots. Beginning to attempt lobs and dinks with little success and doesn't fully understand when and why they should be used.
 - → 3.5: Demonstrates improved stroke dependability with directional control on most medium-paced balls and some faster-paced balls. Demonstrates improved control when trying for direction, depth and power on their shots. Needs to develop variety with their shots. Exhibits some aggressive net play. Beginning to anticipate opponent's shots. Learning about the importance of strategy and teamwork in doubles.



- → 4.0: Consistent and dependable strokes, including directional control and depth on both forehand and backhand shots. Reliable serves, lobs, overheads, approach shots and volleys and can use spin shots with some success. Occasionally can force errors when serving. Rallies may be lost due to impatience. Uses the dink shot and drop shots to slow down or change the pace of the game. Demonstrates 3rd shot strategies drop shots, lobs, and fast-paced ground strokes. Aggressive net play and teamwork in doubles is evident. Fully understands the rules of the game and can play by them.
- → 4.5: Beginning to master the use of power and spin, can successfully execute all shots, can control the depth of their shots, and can handle pace. Beginning to master the dink shots and drop shots and their importance to the game. Beginning to master 3rd shot choices. Displays sound footwork and moves well enough to get to the non-volley zone whenever required. Understands strategy and can adjust style of play and game plan according to the opponent's strengths and weaknesses and court position. Serves with power and accuracy and can also vary the speed and spin of the serve. Understands the importance of "keeping the ball in play" and the effect of making errors. Making good choices in shot selection. Anticipates the opponent's shots resulting in good court positioning.
- → 5: Mastered all the skills all shot types, touch, spin, serves, with control and can use them as weapons. Excellent shot anticipation, extremely accurate shot placement and regularly hit winning shots. Forces opponents into making errors by "keeping the ball in play." Mastered the dink and drop shots. Mastered the 3rd shot choices and strategies. Uses soft shots, dinks and lobs to set up offensive situations. Mastered pickleball strategies and can vary strategies and styles of play in competitive or tournament matches. Dependable in stressful situations as in tournament match play. Athletic ability, quickness, agility, and raw athleticism are also qualities that are sometimes what separates the top players from those near the top.
- → The age division for a Skill Level Doubles team will be determined by the rating of the higher rated player and/or the age of the youngest player on December 31, 2021




HOTSHOT:

- → Each contestant will be allowed two rounds, one-minute each round, to make as many baskets as possible from any of the 5 designated spots. The competition will start under the basket in a lay-up spot.
- \rightarrow Each basket is worth 1 to 5 points depending on the spot from which it is taken:
 - \rightarrow Men: Lay-up (1 point); 15' shots (3 points); 18' shots (4 points); 20' shots (5 points)
 - \rightarrow Women: Lay-up (1 point); 12' shots (3 points); 15' shots (4 points); 17' shots (5 points)
- → A bonus of 15 points will be awarded if a shooter attempts a shot from each one of the designated spots during a round. This bonus is awarded only once per one-minute round.
- → Consecutive shots are not allowed from the lay-up spot. Once a lay-up shot is made, the shooter must move to an area of a different point value and attempt a shot before trying for another lay-up. If a player fails to move to a different spot after a successful lay-up, all successive lay-ups attempted and made will not count until the player moves to and attempts from another point value/area.
- ightarrow Consecutive shots are allowed from any spot except the lay-up spot.
- \rightarrow The best single round score will determine the final score.
- \rightarrow Contestants must rebound their own shots.
- \rightarrow In the case of a tie, multiple medals will be awarded.

FREE THROW AND 3-POINT SHOOT:

- → Each contestant will first shoot 25 free throws and will earn 1 point for each basket made. A total of 25 points is possible. Contestants are allowed 2 practice shots. If one of those is made, the contestant has the option of starting with that shot.
- → Each contestant will then shoot 6 shots from the 3-Point Line (Men: 19 feet, 6 inches / Women: 16 feet 6 inches) and will earn 3 points for each basket made. (Five spots will be marked and the shooter will shoot from all five of the marked spots in order, A to F. The 6th shot may be taken from any one of the five spots). A total of 18 points is possible.
- \rightarrow Points for Free Throws and 3-Point Shots will be added for a final, combined score. A combined total of 43 points is possible.
- \rightarrow Contestants may use rebounders.

RULES/FORMAT:

RULE 1 – PITCHING DIVISIONS

Men 50-69 will pitch 40 foot distance.

Men 70+ and Women may pitch 30 foot distance.

RULE 2 – PLAY OF THE GAME AND VALUE OF THE SHOE

Section A – Innings

The game is divided into innings. Each inning consists of four (4) pitched shoes; two (2) by each contestant.

Section B – Value of the Shoe

- 1. Pitched shoes After all shoes for the inning have been pitched, they are either considered to be "live shoes" or "dead shoes" and may then be scored accordingly.
 - (a) Live Shoe Refers to any shoe that has been pitched in compliance with the rules of the game and that comes to rest within the pit area.
 - (b) Dead Shoe Another term for a foul shoe that was delivered in non-compliance with one of the rules of the game. This term may also refer to a ringer that has been "cancelled" by an opponent's ringer.
- 2. Shoe in Count
 - (a) Ringers A ringer is a *live* shoe that comes to rest while encircling the stake. A straightedge touching either the points or any part of the heel calks of the shoe must clear (not touch) the stake in order to be declared a ringer. A ringer has a value of three (3) points.
 - (b) Points A *live* shoe that is not a ringer, but comes to rest six inches (6") or closer to the stake, has a value of one (1) point. This includes a "leaner".
- 3. Shoe out of Count A shoe that comes to rest more than six inches (6") from the stake is a shoe "out of count" and has no scoring value. A foul shoe is also considered to be a shoe that is out of count, no matter where it comes to rest.

Section C – Delivery of Shoes

- Delivery The contestant pitching first shall deliver both shoes (underhanded, and one at a time) and then the other contestant shall deliver both shoes (underhanded and one at a time). A contestant may deliver the shoes from either the left or right pitching platform, but in any one inning, both shoes must be delivered from the same platform. A contestant shall pitch the entire tournament with the same hand/arm, except in the case of a medical emergency.
- 2. The Pitcher During the entire address and prior to the release of the shoe, the contestant must not start or step completely outside the platform with either foot.
 - Exceptions: A contestant observing the thirty-seven-foot (40') foul line may start directly behind the platform provided they step within it when they release the shoe. Or, a physically challenged contestant requiring assistance of special equipment, such as a wheelchair, must have at least some contact with the platform and be completely behind the twentyseven-foot (30') foul line when the shoe is released.
- 3. Accidental Release Any shoe that leaves a contestant's hand once the final step (if taken) and final forward swing of the delivery process has started, shall count as a pitched shoe. A shoe that is accidentally dropped by a contestant before the final step (if taken) and final forward swing has started, shall not be considered a foul shoe and may be picked up and pitched.

- \rightarrow The match shall be played until the first team reaches (or exceeds) 21 points. The winning team does not need to win by two or more points.
- → Cancellation Scoring corn bags in-the-hole and corn bags in-the-count pitched by opponents during an inning or half of an inning in doubles play cancel each other out. Only non cancelled corn bags are counted in the score for the inning.
