COVID-19 Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home -

All residents and staff continue to test negative for COVID-19 and no residents are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. Today is the last day of precautionary isolation.

Limited visitation will resume on Monday, November 9th. All visits must be scheduled in advance according to the unit the resident resides on as follows:

Monday – 4th Floor
Tuesday – 5th Floor
Wednesday – 6th Floor
Thursday – 3rd Floor
Friday – 2nd Floor

As a reminder, all visitors are required to be screened before the visit and present a negative COVID-19 PCR test result that was conducted within 7 days prior to the visit. Face masks must be worn at all times while on facility premises. Visitors are limited to 2 per resident and must be 18 years or older. Visitation will be outdoors, weather permitting.

Virtual visits are available everyday. Please contact Social Services or Recreation to set this up.
