Those nominees appearing on this ballot will have five minutes each to address the Members immediately prior to 'inperson' elections. Nominees, who may want to introduce themselves to PESC Members sooner as they may not be as familiar with the official voting representatives from each PESC Member or who wish to communicate with Members over the coming weeks, are able to communicate directly and independently with official voting representatives. The PESC office also offers to facilitate a maximum of two (2) communications (emails, letters, etc.) from each nominee at their request. In turn the PESC office will issue that nominee's communication(s) to the PESC Members over the PESC Member listserve.

NOTE THAT PESC DOES NOT ACCEPT 'WRITE-IN' CANDIDATES.

Due to specific bylaws requiring diversity in directorship representation, a slate of nominees is presented from which Members vote.

At this time there are eight (8) nominees for six (6) Board of Director seats.
