This year we have scheduled the event for Saturday, instead of Sunday, You are invited to participate, as as part of our living history program.

In order to avoid duplication of interpretations and items for sale, we are offering the following options:

1. For those who wish to interpret a period skill and sell their wares, a sutler's fee of 10% of their gross sales is requested. Sutlers are responsible for Maryland sales tax.
2. For those who wish to interpret a skill without sales, a \$35 travel stipend will be paid. An additional \$15 stipend will be paid for one assistant. In order to qualify for these stipends, the interpreter and their interpretation MUST be pre approved.
3. For either option, camping is available Friday and Saturday nights.
