RECITAL FEE



WHAT'S STRONG BY ZUMBA?

This is not your normal Zumba class, actually it's nothing like Zumba. STRONG by Zumba is an interval or intermittent intensity style program. High intensity moves (such as high knees, burpees, jumping jacks, etc) are interchanged with lower intensity moves (like lunges, jump rope, kickboxing) throughout the entire workout. Modifications are provided for various fitness levels, so nearly everyone can take the class and be successful and progress.

The class is normally 55 minutes and is divided into four Quadrants:

Warm Up Q1: Ignite Q 2: Fire-Up

Q 3: Push Your Limits

Q 4: FloorPlay CoolDown

Moves, such plank shooters, runners lunge, shoulder presses, are explained and demonstrated at the beginning class so participants are prepared.

What to bring with you: water and a yoga mat, weight lifting gloves (optional).

This class is open to anyone over the age of 14. No dance experience necessary.
