### Misleading Finals

**Appalachian State (-2) lost to Coastal Carolina 38-24.** However, App St had a 376-353 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. They fumbled at the Coastal 4-yard line, were SOD at the Coastal 35 and an interception set up a 1-yard TD drive.

**Cincinnati (-5.5) lost to West Virginia 31-24.** However, Cincinnati had a 436-248 yard edge but WVU got a 79-yard interception return TD and a 14-yard fumble return TD.

**Navy (-4.5) beat South Florida 28-7.** However, USF was intercepted at the Navy 19, stopped on downs at the Navy 28, intercepted at the Navy 43, fumbled at the Navy 35 and were stopped on downs at the Navy 5.

**Colorado (-4.5) beat Texas Tech 41-27.** However, Tech had a 388-351 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. The Red Raiders missed a FG, were stopped on downs at the Colorado 1-yard line and Colorado got a fumble-return TD in the final minute.

**San Jose State (+3) upset Oregon State 24-13.** However, Oregon State had a 474-463 yard edge. The Beavers fumbled at the San Jose 20-yard line, were intercepted at the San Jose 2 and San Jose got a 16-yard interception return TD.

**Arizona State (-2.5) beat UCF 35-31.** However, UCF had a 406-260 yard edge. ASU got a punt block return TD and a "Pick 6".

**Western Kentucky (-17.5) beat New Mexico State 41-28.** However, New Mexico State had a 460-413 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

### Bad Beats

**UAB (+8) lost to Connecticut 31-23.** However, UAB had a 403-365 yard edge and led 20-3 at halftime. The only time they weren't covering the game was in the final minutes after a long UConn TD.

**North Texas (+6.5) lost to Army 14-3.** However, North Texas was stopped on downs at the Army 2-yard line when a controversial replay review saw a TD overturned. North Texas also threw not one, but two interceptions in the Army end zone.

**Louisiana Tech was +310 on the money-line vs Jacksonville State.** Jacksonville State would hit a 49-yard "Hail Mary" TD pass on the final play to force OT where they won it 44-37.

**The total in the Oklahoma/Missouri game was 42.** Missouri won 30-23. How could that be a bad beat? Well, the score was just Missouri 10-9 with less than 10 minutes left. OU got a 18-yard TD pass to tie it at 16-16 with 3:18 left. Then OU got a 43-yard fumble return TD with 2:00 left (OU 23-16). Missouri went 75 yards in 8 plays and got a TD with 1:03 left to tie it back up at 23-23. Then Missouri got the game-winning 17-yard fumble return TD with :22 left.

## Games in Rotation Order

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

### Wednesday, November 13th

**MIAMI, OH 38 Kent State 9.** Kent State is easily the worst team in the country. They are dead last in ypp margin (-3.0), ypg margin (-291.2) and scoring margin (-30.9). They are 2-7 ATS this season failing to cover by 10.4 ppg. We can't downgrade our power ratings fast enough. With that being said, it's tough laying 30.5 points with a Miami offense that averages 23 ppg.

**OHIO 31 Eastern Michigan 21.** EMU is a fraudulent 5-4 as they rank No. 120 in ypp margin (-1.3) but are +7 in TO's. Meanwhile Ohio is No. 36 (+0.9) but are -8 in TO's. A lot of money on Ohio this week but we can't recommend laying the current number. EMU is on a 29-7-1 ATS run as a road underdog since 2016.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS 30 Akron 15.** Akron's No. 121 offense (320 ypg) is really up against it vs a NIU defense that ranks No. 8 (288 ypg). With that being said, NIU has been Jekyll and Hyde all season (beat ND, lose to Buffalo) due to injuries and a coach that doesn't always seem to have the players motivated. Could be some rain in the forecast.

### Thursday, November 14th

**East Carolina 37 TULSA 26.** After ECU fired their head coach Mike Houston, they've been playing their best ball of the season. A lot of it has to do with the switch to Katin Houser at QB, who has thrown 8 TD passes the last two weeks combined and so far isn't the TO machine Jake Garcia was. Tulsa has had an up and down season but only rank No. 125 in ypp margin. A lot of money on ECU this week, but our numbers were closer to the openers. We did bet OVER.

### Friday, November 15th

**COLORADO STATE 30 Wyoming 20.** The Border War dates back to 1899 with this being the 116th meeting. The winner gets the Bronze Boot. Colorado State has been doing a lot of winning for their backers as they have covered 6 straight games. Wyoming has also played better as of late with 3 straight covers. Still, the Cowboys rank No. 127 in ypp margin. We didn't bet side or total but do lean OVER.

**North Texas 35 UTSA 34.** North Texas was one of our favorite plays last week but somehow scored a grand total of ZERO points with three trips inside the Army 10-yard line. We expect the offense to rebound vs a UTSA defense that ranks No. 113 in scoring (NT ranks No. 119 in scoring D). We didn't bet side or total but this should come down to the wire.

**WASHINGTON 24 UCLA 20** UCLA is on a 6-1 ATS run with their only non-cover coming by a 0.5-point vs Minnesota after a big line move. The Bruins have pulled three straight outright upsets and are now thinking bowl game. At 5-5 and with only No. 1 Oregon left, Washington needs a win here if they want to go to a bowl. They are No. 23 in ypp margin and No. 24 in ypg margin while UCLA ranks No. 83 and No. 99 in those categories.

**Houston 23 ARIZONA 22.** Houston has the No. 132 scoring offense in the country averaging only 15 ppg. However, the move to QB Zeon Chriss has paid off as the Cougars have pulled 3 big outright upsets in their last 4 games. Meanwhile, Arizona is the worst ATS team in the country at 1-8 failing to cover by 15 ppg. A lot of pro money on Houston so far in this game and we agree.

### Saturday, November 16th

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN 33 Troy 23.** It is notable that Troy has the much better ypp margin (-0.4) than Georgia Southern (-1.3). It is mainly due to a GS defense that ranks No. 127 allowing 458 ypg. Troy's offense has been better as of late, but we don't think they keep pace here.

**MARSHALL 32 Coastal Carolina 24.** Both teams protect the QB on offense and get after the QB on defense as Coastal is +12 in sack margin while Marshall is +19. Marshall is +0.8 in ypp margin while Coastal is 0.0. We passed on the side but did bet OVER.

**TEMPLE 25 Florida Atlantic 24.** FAU QB Cam Fancher is out for the season and at 2-7 with 4 straight losses, you have to wonder if head coach Tom Herman is going to see Year 3. Temple was playing better until they ran into the AAC's best team Tulane last week. Tough backing Temple as a favorite but they did cover vs Tulsa in that role. Pass.

**James Madison 28 OLD DOMINION 24.** JMU has the much better ypp margin (No. 20) vs ODU (No. 85). However, ODU has played the much tougher schedule (No. 70 vs No. 129). ODU is back in their preferred underdog role as they have pulled 4 outright upsets already this season (of course we bet their season win total UNDER). Young QB Colton Joseph (10-3 ratio, 454 rushing yards) has been a big reason why they have won 3 of their last 4 games. JMU's defense ranks No. 10 in ypp and scoring. A sharp group took OSU early this week but we're passing.

**Texas 35 ARKANSAS 22.** Two former Southwest Conference rivals who have only played 6 times since Arkansas left to join the SEC in 1992. Now they're back to being conference rivals. Arkansas is off a bye and that should equate to QB Green being healthy enough to play. Texas' defense ranks No. 1 in ypp and No. 2 in total D but they haven't faced a lot of good offenses. Arkansas ranks No. 11 in ypp and No. 5 in total offense. We agree with the early money on Arkansas.

**NORTH CAROLINA 36 Wake Forest 25.** North Carolina is off back-to-back blowout wins and a bye. They rank No. 4 in the country with 32 sacks this season. Wake Forest ranks No. 120 allowing 29 sacks this season. We don't see much value in the side. Generally, you think OVER with NC games but the UNDER is on a 4-1 run.

**South Florida 29 CHARLOTTE 26.** Charlotte is -0.8 in ypp margin playing the No. 55 schedule while USF is -0.7 in ypp margin playing the No. 79 schedule. Charlotte needs to win out to get to a bowl while USF needs to win 2 of their final 3. Early money is on Charlotte but we don't see value at current.

**Liberty 33 MASSACHUSETTS 20.** UMass QB Taisun Phommachanh is out for the season. The offense did rank just No. 124 in ypp and No. 114 in ypg with him in the lineup. Liberty is just 2-6 ATS this season failing to cover by 10.7 ppg but did cover in their last game. Liberty has played one of the weakest schedules (Sagarin No. 156) in the country and have two important conference games on deck vs WKU and Sam Houston. We bet UMass.

**WESTERN KENTUCKY 33 Louisiana Tech 20.** LT has been a tough luck team under Sonny Cumbie with a 3-12 record in one-possession games including 2-5 this season. Last week they lost when Jacksonville State hit a 49-yard "Hail Mary" TD pass on the final play to force OT. WKU is 7-1 since losing to Alabama in the opener and the only loss was to Boston College by 1 point. With that being said, WKU is +0.4 in ypp margin, LT is +0.3. We bet LT.

**Baylor 30 WEST VIRGINIA 29.** Decent spot for Baylor off 3 straight wins and a bye. QB Sawyer Robertson has played well including No. 6 in QBR and the rush offense has topped 250 yards in each of those 3 wins. The Bears are +1.0 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, WVU is off back-to-back outright upsets. Last week they got outgained 436-248 by Cincinnati but scored a pair of defensive TD's in the 31-24 win. QB Garrett Greene looks like he could return here. Baylor flipped from dog to favorite this week and we agree.

**Tulane 31 NAVY 24.** Two of the most improved teams in the country since the start of the season. We've upgrade Tulane 9.5 points as they are 8-2 ATS covering by 12.1 ppg. They rank in the Top 20 in ypp, ypg and scoring margins. Meanwhile, Navy got a bounce back win and cover at USF last week. Tulane coach Jon Sumrall while at Troy the last two years defended Army's option very well. While Army and Navy have gotten the publicity this year. Tulane is the best team in the AAC and prove it on Saturday.

**Clemson 31 PITTSBURGH 21.** Pittsburgh's high-powered offense has started to slip the last 4 games as they have only averaged 26 ppg and 310 ypg after averaging 46 ppg and 522 ypg the first 5 games. They're off back-to-back losses and still have road games at Louisville and Boston College. It could be a tough close. Meanwhile, Clemson got a bounce back win over VT last week. Outside of Louisville's rush attack two weeks ago, the Tigers defense has been tough in recent weeks. We bet UNDER.

† **Ohio State 38 Northwestern 9.** Game will be played at Wrigley Field in Chicago, IL. Total mismatch here between Northwestern's No. 131 offense averaging 288 ypg vs Ohio State's No. 1 defense allowing 251 ypg. The Buckeyes do have huge games vs Indiana and Michigan on deck so do they have the motivation for margin?

**GEORGIA STATE 29 Arkansas St 27.** We thought this game offered up some value on Georgia State. Yes, they've only covered one game this season. But they are better in ypp margin (-0.9 vs -1.6) and have played a tougher schedule than Arkansas State (No. 68 vs No. 87). Arkansas St is a fraudulent 5-4 team and got blown out by ULL last week.

**MARYLAND 28 Rutgers 23.** That was a big upset win for Rutgers last week over Minnesota. The Scarlet Knights had to stop the bleeding from a 4-game losing streak and they did it without their star RB Kyle Monangai. Maryland took some money in the market last week and covered vs Oregon. We lean with Rutgers.

**Penn State 38 PURDUE 10.** Clearly, the CFB Playoff committee likes this Penn State team as the Nittany Lions are No. 4 despite ZERO POINT ZERO wins over current Top 25 teams. They can name the score here vs a Purdue team that is 2nd to last in scoring margin and is 1-7 ATS vs FBS foes failing to cover by 13.8 ppg.



**AUBURN 34 UL-Monroe 10.** Auburn is 3-6 this season despite the fact they've been an underdog of more than a FG only one time. They rank No. 11 in ypp margin and No. 17 in ypg margin but are -10 in TO's and don't do the little things well. ULM got off to a 5-1 start but has lost their last 3. Their offense ranks just No. 126 averaging 301 ypg. We haven't bet side or total.

**UL-LAFAYETTE 33 South Alabama 25.** South Alabama is a little under-valued at 4-5. They are off a bye after blowing a 30-14 lead vs Georgia Southern. The Jags offense ranks No. 14 in ypp and ypg. ULL has been incredibly consistent this year. They rank No. 13 in ypp margin and No. 14 in ypg margin with an 8-1 record and easily sit atop the Sun Belt standings. Some early respected money on SA.

**Washington State 43 NEW MEXICO 30.** At 8-1 and No. 18 in the CFB Playoff, they're still some slim chance Washington State can sneak in to the playoffs but they need a ton of help. Their No. 113 defense might be up against it this week vs the No. 6 New Mexico offense. The problem is New Mexico's defense ranks No. 131 and allows 38 ppg and is facing a Washington State offense that ranks No. 8 in scoring. We bet Washington State.

**BYU 28 Kansas 27.** This is a sneaky game for the unbeaten Cougars who moved up to No. 6 in the CFB Playoff rankings last night. BYU is a little overrated due to a 4-0 record in close games. That includes a come-from-behind controversial win over rival Utah last week. Meanwhile, Kansas is 0-5 in one possession games and under-valued. Kansas has covered 3 straight and just beat Iowa State outright after nearly beating Kansas State outright on the road. We bet Kansas.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE 36 Florida International 21.** Jacksonville State has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) but did need a "Hail Mary" last week. FIU has covered 4 of their last 5 and is coming off a bye. We didn't bet side or total.

**Louisville 39 STANFORD 19.** The CFB Playoff committee thinks highly of 3-loss Louisville as they have them No. 19. We agree and have Louisville No. 17 in our power ratings. They rank No. 16 in ypp margin. Did the bye help a banged up Stanford team? The Cardinal have lost 6 straight going 0-5-1 ATS. They rank No. 129 in ypp margin. Our numbers exactly match the current market.

**Sam Houston 30 KENNESAW STATE 14.** There is some big time trouble at Kennesaw State this week. They fired their only coach in history Brian Bohannon. 28-year old Chandler Burks is the interim. Their top DL hit the transfer portal. Sam Houston is off a bye and should get their QB Hunter Watson back from injury. Kennesaw's offense is dead last in ypp and now face a Sam Houston defense that's allowed a combined 10 points the last two games.

**CALIFORNIA 32 Syracuse 24.** Cal is underrated due to 4 losses by a combined 9 points. They are +0.7 in ypp margin while Syracuse -0.4 in ypp margin. We think the Orange are a little overrated. They are 4-2 in close games including a couple of OT wins. This is a super long travel spot for them after playing on the road last week. With that being said, we're a little surprised this line is north of a TD.

**Hawaii 31 UTAH STATE 29.** A lot of money on Hawaii and the UNDER here and we're a part of both as this opened Utah State -3 and the total 64.5. Hawaii is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight covers. Utah State is just 2-7 ATS and just playing out the season with an interim. Their defense ranks No. 133 allowing 42 ppg.

**SMU 35 Boston College 20.** Boston College QB Thomas Castellanos has been benched and Grayson James will get the start here. Castellanos has left the team and we think the market has overreacted. We love this SMU team as they rank No. 14 in ypp margin and we just bet them in their last game. However, we can't get to a 17.5-point spread here. BC is only allowing 23 ppg and likes to run. The offense played better with James at QB last week.

**TEXAS STATE 40 Southern Miss 15.** Southern Miss is just playing out the season with an interim coach. They are No. 130 in ypp margin and No. 131 in scoring margin. Texas State has been a big disappointment at 5-4 as they've been favored in every game. They still rank No. 28 in ypp margin and No. 22 in ypg margin. Pass.

**GEORGIA 28 Tennessee 18.** Tennessee has the better stats (+2.1 ypp margin vs +1.3). However, they have played the No. 54 schedule while Georgia has played the toughest schedule. Georgia is just 2-7 ATS on the season. Their two covers (Clemson and Texas) were in two of their bigger games of the season. A loss here and they can kiss the CFB playoffs goodbye. We expect them to be super motivated following the loss at Ole Miss. Tennessee QB Nico Iamaleava is questionable here. Can the Tennessee defense cause enough havoc? We bet Georgia on the openers and the market agrees. At current, we lean UNDER.

**SOUTH CAROLINA 29 Missouri 16.** South Carolina is an underrated team. They are 7-2 ATS with a cover margin of 12.4 points per game. We have them No. 13 in our power ratings despite the 3 losses. They're playing an overrated Missouri team that ranks No. 23 in the CFB Playoff rankings but we have them No. 46 in our power ratings. Will they get QB Brady Cook back here?

**IOWA STATE 30 Cincinnati 22.** Iowa State comes in off back-to-back upset losses. Is this a "Buy Low" spot for them? Certainly, not at current market vs a Cincinnati team that had a misleading loss to West Virginia last week (436-248 yard edge but allowed two defensive TD's). Iowa State is much better in the stats (+1.1 ypp margin vs +0.2)

**NOTRE DAME 36 Virginia 15.** Since the loss to Northern Illinois, Notre Dame has won 7 straight games by 34 ppg and have gone 6-1 ATS with an average cover of 17 ppg. They rank in Top 10 in ypp, ypg and scoring margins for the season and want a home playoff game. UVA did get a road upset over Pitt last week and just need one more win for bowl eligibility. Obviously, we don't see it here.

**MEMPHIS 38 Uab 22.** Despite an 8-2 overall record, Memphis has only covered once in their last 8 games. Meanwhile, UAB has been playing better as of late. However, last week they did blow a 20-3 half-time lead vs Connecticut and you start to wonder what frame of mind they will be in with head coach Dilfer likely gone after this season. Our power ratings like Memphis here.

**Oregon State 24 AIR FORCE 21.** Last week Oregon State lost another game outright as a favorite. They are now just 2-7 ATS on the season and last year's team would have been more than a 3-TD favorite vs this year's team. Meanwhile, Air Force has covered two straight but the Falcons are also 2-7 ATS on the season. Last week's upset win over Fresno was by far their best performance of the season and we think they're the sharp side this week.

**COLORADO 29 Utah 18.** Utah is off another tough loss. After starting the season 4-0, we don't think they're heading for a bowl. QB Brandon Rose who started last week's game is out for the season now and so is TE Kuithe. Meanwhile, it looks like Colorado is heading to the Big 12 Championship game if they take care of business.

**Lsu 30 FLORIDA 24.** Will DJ Lagway play or not here for Florida? If he doesn't go, this line seems a bit cheap considering they'd be playing their 3rd string walk-on. LSU has been eliminated from the playoffs after last week's embarrassing home blowout loss to Alabama. How will they respond. We lean Tigers.

**KANSAS STATE 30 Arizona State 22.** As of Wednesday morning, it looks like Arizona State RB Cam Skattebo will try to play this week. We know ASU won last week without him and scored 35 points, but it was misleading as they scored two defensive TD's. They only managed 260 yards, by far their lowest of the season. They're catching Kansas State off a bye. We think Kansas State is the sharp side.

**ILLINOIS 24 Michigan State 23.** We like Michigan State here. MSU is better in ypp margin (+0.2 vs -0.1) and have played the much tougher schedule (No. 12 vs No. 45). QB Chiles should play here and we trust head coach Smith much more than Bielema with both teams coming off a bye week.

**Boise State 37 SAN JOSE STATE 24.** A dangerous game for Boise here who arguably had their worst performance of the season last week in a 28-21 win over Nevada as a 3-TD plus home favorite. San Jose is No. 19 in ypp margin (+1.4) and does a good job protecting their QB (only allowed 9 sacks so far this season).

**USC 29 Nebraska 21.** For a game so late in the season, there are a lot of moving parts here. First, USC benched QB Miller Moss and will go to Jayden Maiva here. Second, Nebraska fired their OC and hired Dana Holgorsen to be their play-calling. Dana just joined the team in recent weeks. QB Raiola is expected to play after getting dinged up in their last game. Both teams need the game if they want to get to a bowl.

**Oregon 31 WISCONSIN 17.** Oregon might be No. 1 in the CFB Playoff rankings and deservedly so however, we only have them No. 4. They are No. 12 in ypp margin, No. 8 in ypg margin and No. 11 in scoring margin so they haven't been overly dominant. Wisconsin is off a bye after getting embarrassed by Iowa. Fickell is going to have to make changes to his staff. We lean UNDER.

**TEXAS A&M 48 New Mexico State 8.** A&M is off a bye and can name the score. New Mexico St is bottom 5 in ypp and ypg margins and have played a much weaker schedule. Pass.

**UNLV 38 San Diego State 20.** UNLV still controls its destiny for the Mountain West championship and a possible playoff berth. They rank No. 22 in ypp margin and No. 16 in scoring margin despite playing a tougher schedule than most MW teams. The Aztecs have really struggled in year one under Lewis but this number seems too rich.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). ## **HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

### **Thursday, November 14th**

**PHILADELPHIA 27 Washington 23.** Back-to-back weeks with a really good game on Thursday night football. That doesn't happen often. Even after blowing the 24-14 lead to the Steelers, Washington is still 7-2-1 ATS but they have benefitted from playing a bottom 5 schedule. We think the Eagles are the better team as they are +0.9 in ypp margin (WAS +0.5). They're the more experienced and more talented roster and usually, these short weeks are about the "Jimmy's and Joe's" and not the "X's and O's".

### **Sunday, November 17th**

**Green Bay 23 CHICAGO 17.** The Bears are a pathetic professional sports franchise who are now 14-29 under Eberflus. They've ruined the rookie season of QB Williams and have fired their OC. Last week's 19-3 loss to the Patriots was arguably the worst loss of any team in the league this year (Bears were favored by 6 and they were 1 of 14 on 3rd Down). The Bears have played one of the easiest schedules in the NFL and yet are -1.1 in ypp margin (No. 31). They welcome in a model pro sports franchise in the Packers who are +0.8 in ypp margin (No. 4). The Packers have played a Top 6 toughest schedule so far and with a banged up QB. The Packers are 26-5 SU and 24-7 ATS at Chicago since 1994!

**NEW ORLEANS 23 Cleveland 21.** The Browns come in off a bye. Obviously, it's been an incredibly disappointing season as they rank dead last in ypp margin (-1.3). They are facing a Saints team that snapped a 7-game losing streak in Darren Rizzi's debut last week. Will the interim coach bump last one week or carry-over? The Saints are the better team statistically and at home but we don't trust either team.

**L.A. Rams 24 NEW ENGLAND 20.** Don't look now but the Patriots have covered 3 straight games while winning 2 of them outright. The only loss came in OT. However, they still rank No. 30 in ypp margin. The Rams come in off an upset home loss to the Dolphins on MNF. Short prep week with cross-country travel is not a great spot even though they are clearly the better team.

**Baltimore 23 PITTSBURGH 21.** Each of the last 8 meetings between these two have been decided by 7 points or less with the Steelers winning 7 of the 8. Statistically, the Ravens are the superior team with a +1.4 ypp margin (No. 2). Meanwhile, the 7-2 SU and ATS Steelers are dead even in ypp margin (No. 18). Each of the last 7 meetings have come in UNDER this number and that's where our preferred lean is. That's despite the fact Baltimore games are 9-1 to the OVER this year. Baltimore did see their streak of 42 straight games with at least 100 yards rushing come to an end last week (Lamar kneel down did it). Baltimore did rally from a 21-7 deficit mid-3Q while the Steelers also rallied last week.

**MIAMI 27 Las Vegas 20.** Miami comes in off the upset win over the Rams on MNF. The Dolphins saved the state of Florida from going 0-12 last weekend as FBS/FCS/NFL teams were a combined 0-11 for the first time ever. The Raiders do have the rest edge coming in off a bye. The Dolphins stats are skewed because they played games without QB Tua. However, we can't lay more than a TD here. We do lean OVER.

**DETROIT 31 Jacksonville 16.** This is the biggest point spread in the NFL this season. The Lions are 7-2 ATS and somehow won last week despite 5 INT's from Goff and a 23-7 halftime deficit at Houston. Detroit ranks No. 1 in DVOA and Sagarin's ratings. Meanwhile, Jacksonville had a misleading 12-7 loss to Minnesota. They should have been destroyed (outgained 402-143). In the last 10 years, double-digit favorites in the NFL are 57% ATS (153-116-10).

**Minnesota 23 TENNESSEE 17.** After a 5-0 ATS start, Minnesota has only covered once in their last 4 games. They should have covered last week as they out-gained Jacksonville 402-143 but somehow only won 12-7. Tennessee is just 1-8 ATS this season. That's despite a ypp margin of 0.0 which signifies they should be a lot better than 2-7 SU. We don't see much value in this one.

**SAN FRANCISCO 27 Seattle 20.** San Francisco is probably a little underrated. The 49ers are No. 1 in ypp margin (+1.4) and somehow have a 5-4 record despite being favored in every game. Last week they didn't cover vs Tampa Bay despite a 413-215 yard edge and a 6.8-3.7 yards per play edge. Seattle is off a bye. The Seahawks needed it as they are 1-5 SU and 1-5 ATS since a 3-0 start. With McCaffrey back, our ratings like SF here.

**DENVER 23 Atlanta 21.** Two teams who have played similar schedules. Atlanta is +0.5 in ypp margin, while Denver is +0.3. The Broncos nearly ended the Chiefs win streak last week but their game-winning FG was blocked. The Broncos still covered and are 7-3 ATS on the season. Meanwhile, Atlanta suffered an upset loss to the Saints as they missed 3 FG's. With not much separating these teams from a power ratings aspect, we like Atlanta in a teaser.

**BUFFALO 24 Kansas City 23.** What a matchup. The Chiefs have won 15 straight games dating back to last season, the longest streak in the NFL since the Patriots won 19 in a row 2010-2011. The Bills are 8-2 for the first time since 1993. Statistically, the Bills are the superior team as they are +0.4 in ypp margin (KC +0.1). Patrick Mahomes is 12-1-1 ATS as an underdog in his career. 11 of those covers are outright wins! Tough going against Mahomes as a dog but we prefer to take the Chiefs in a teaser.

**Cincinnati 24 L.A. CHARGERS 23. This game got flexed to Sunday Night Football.** What a difference a coach makes. Jim Harbaugh has the Chargers 6-3 (6-2-1 ATS) one season after they went 5-12. Meanwhile, Michigan is 5-5 one year after Harbaugh led them to a 15-0 record. Do note the Chargers have played the weakest schedule so far in the NFL. The Bengals despite playing a tougher schedule, have a better ypp margin (+0.4 vs +0.2). Cincy should be better than their 4-6 record as they are just 1-5 in one possession games this season. They do have extra prep after blowing the 14-point lead vs Baltimore last Thursday. Cincy outright as they become the first team to top 20 points vs the Chargers all season.

**N.Y. JETS 23 Indianapolis 20.** The Colts are going back to Richardson at QB after Flacco had a 2-4 ratio the last two weeks. If you're going to have a QB make a ton of mistakes, it might as well be the youngster. The Colts are still 7-3 ATS this season. Meanwhile, the Jets are a pathetic 3-7 SU and ATS. The Jets take money almost every week in the market and we have to question the sanity of it. Last week they went from PK to -2 at Arizona and lost 31-6. Not even close. Statistically, they are the better team (+0.1 ypp vs -0.2). Thank God this game got flexed out of Sunday Night Football. We can't back the Jets but also can't back Richardson.

### **Monday, November 18th**

**Houston 24 DALLAS 17.** The Cowboys are a pathetic 2-7 ATS this season. QB Prescott is now out for the season. They are No. 28 in ypp margin. They're facing a Houston team that somehow couldn't beat the Lions last week despite 5 interceptions from Detroit QB Goff. The Texans blew a 23-7 halftime lead. Will they get healthy at WR again here? While we don't see much value on the side, we do think Houston is a good teaser option.
