GENERAL SESSION – Wednesday A.M.

<u>Preliminary Credentials Report</u>: Susan Marcell, Credentials Chair, reported 176 delegates and 5 alternates registered.

<u>Motion:</u> A motion was made to add a rule #5 that Photo ID be shown at election m/s/c

Motion: A motion was made to adopt the AzFRW 2105 Convention Rules as amended. **Adopted**

<u>Convention Program:</u> 1st Vice President Loraine Pellegrino read the Program changes. <u>Motion:</u> A motion was made to add 'Election of Nominating Committee Representatives by Region to follow after Candidates Remarks, **m/s/c**

<u>Motion:</u> A motion was made to amend that the presentation of the Campaign Awards will be done first followed by other awards as published. **m/s/c**

<u>Motion:</u> A motion was made under the Committee Report section to move the last paragraph under the Lake Havasu Republican Women report to the London Bridge Republican Women report. **m/s/c**

<u>Motion:</u> A motion was made under the Committee Report section to replace Lake Havasu Republican Women to London Bridge Republican Women under the AzFRW 2015 Teacher of the Year Award report. **m/s/c**

<u>Motion:</u> A motion was made to adopt the AzFRW 2015 Convention Program as amended. **Adopted**
