TODDLER PROGRAM

1-3 YEARS

PRIMARY PROGRAM

3-6 YEARS

The Primary program nurtures each child's lifelong love of learning. The environment is open to meet the needs of the whole child; body, mind and spirit. The children work at their own pace with self-chosen materials.

Our knowledgeable teachers carefully observe the needs of each child and present new lessons when the child demonstrates readiness. The child learns to respect themselves, their environment, and those around them.

KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

5-6 YEARS

This culminating year offers the children the opportunity to develop leadership as well as extend their knowledge and skills. The students receive more advanced lessons in math, language, culture. They are also provided group activities that promote social awareness and a sense of community.

Our goal is to assist in the development of a strong self-esteem, advanced problem solving skills and of course a life-long love of learning.

The kindergarten program has been aligned with the State standards for math and language in the state of Wyoming.

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

PRACTICAL LIFE

This area enhances the development of a sense of order, concentration, coordination, and independence.

SENSORIAL

The area is intended to increase a child's ability to explore the world using their five senses. This is also the child's first introduction to mathematical concepts such as weight, dimension, quantity and measurement.

LANGUAGE

The focus is on exploring the beauty of both written and oral language through the use of objects and hands on manipulation.

MATHEMATICS

Our materials promote self discovery of mathematical concepts. The children are introduced to the decimal system, static and dynamic operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

SCIENCE

An exciting area where children begin to understand physical and natural science through lots of hands on exploration.

CULTURE & GEOGRAPHY

This area focuses on the study of our world, history, and an appreciation and awareness of other cultures.
