Below are some general operator instructions to follow to ensure safety of all bouncers! Do not hesitate to call if you have a question.

OPERATOR INSTRUCTIONS:

- Direct adult supervision is required at all times. At no time should the unit be left unattended while children are present.
- Ensure the number of participants on the unit at one time does not exceed the limit below:
 - Princess Castle and Sports Combo Unit: Ages 7 and under—5 to 6 riders; Ages 7 to 12—4 riders; Ages 12 and up—2 r. (No more than 600 pounds).
 - 38 Foot, 32 Foot Obstacle Course, Mutiny (pirate ship), Joust (if used as joust): no more than two riders at a time. (No more than 600 pounds).
 - Circle, Castle, Brave Knight, and Giraffe Bounce House: Ages 7 and under—5 to 6 riders; Ages 7 to 12—4 riders; Ages 12 and up—2 riders. (No more than 600 pounds).
 - Giant Slide (wet or dry): one rider at a time
- Jumpers should not flip, wrestle, or pile. Jumpers should use the slide(s) feet first.
- Jumpers should not bounce against the walls, near the door entry/area, or on the entry ramp. They should not climb on the unit, or hang from the netting.
- Do not put water inside the inflatables (exception: giant slide if used wet). Units are not waterproof. In addition, jumping inside the bouncer can be dangerous if the surface is slippery.
- All jumpers must remove their shoes and items from their pockets prior to entering the inflatable.
- No food, pets, water balloons, water guns, confetti, drinks, candy, silly string, and/or gum allowed inside or near the inflatable.
- Do not remove the inflatable from the area where it is installed. Ensure the sandbags/ground stakes are securely fastened at all times.
- If the inflatable begins to deflate:
 - All jumpers should evacuate the unit immediately. Never allow jumpers to jump in a partially inflated unit.
 - If the blower(s) has stopped running:
 - Check to ensure it is plugged in.
 - Check the air-intake screen on the blower for blockages.
 - Check the outlet and circuit breaker.

- Check blower tubes to ensure that they are tightly secured to the blowers.
- In case of rain or thunderstorms:
 - Remove all persons from the inflatable and turn off the blower(s).
 - Unplug the blower(s) and pull the blower(s) indoors or cover the blower(s).
 - When the weather is clear, turn on the blower(s), and dry off the inside of the inflatable with a soft, clean towel before allowing jumpers back in.
