Spoken: The Rhythm of God's Word Words, Words, Words!

Our lives are filled with words: Direct conversations, overheard conversations and the non-stop drone of the TV. Words spill at us through emails, blogs and social media. Everybody seems to have something to say.

This ceaseless flow of words; though, often brings mixed messages. It's like the cacophony of an orchestra warming up for a concert. Each musician plays what he or she wants, and the combined sounds can be downright unpleasant. The noise has no rhyme or reason.

The word of God has spoken to us – the Bible – is different—far different. Even though over 40 different people were used by God to write over a period of 1,500 years, we hear the steady rhythm of God's heart throughout. Regardless of the time period, the style and the purpose of each book in God's Word, He has spoken clearly and consistently – and His words still speak.

Psalm 119 has a single focus: to make known the beauty and power of God's Word to speak into our lives. In this study, we will discover the way God has spoken throughout Scripture. When we listen to what God has spoken through Scripture, the rhythm of God's Word becomes the rhythm of our own lives

"January Church School Lesson...continued" Created For a Purpose God created us for a purpose!

It's quite satisfying to go through life with a purpose. Unfortunately, not all of us experience that satisfaction. Worse, we may even look at others and wonder what their purpose is. Sadly, our culture often determines a person's value by how much that person can contribute to society, or at least not be a burden to others. If an individual's purpose is not apparent to others, those others may question his very worth as a person. But God never sees us that way. Every person has inherent value and purpose as a human created in the image of God. Jeremiah discovered his purpose from God. As we look at the call God placed on Jeremiah's life, we discover principles that apply to all of us. Regardless of how the world sees us — or how we see ourselves — God has created us for a purpose.

Thrive: Living in Real Joy

The Book of Philippians answers many of our deepest questions

Where can we find full and lasting joy? Look and listen to Paul. He radiated a contagious joy in this letter. Indeed, the happiest man in Rome was in Jail! Paul reminds us that we don't derive ultimate joy from comfortable circumstances, but from a living, vibrant communion with Christ. Joy isn't about attaining more stuff; it's about treasuring Christ more. Where can we find meaning and purpose in life? Paul teaches us about a life worth living — and a death worth dying. He shows us the path to living this life by pointing us to Jesus, who provides the power and the example we need. The Christian life isn't an easy life, but it's a full and joyful life. Jesus never promised us that life would be easy, but He did promise He would always be with us. And since He is with us, we have everything we need for joy and peace. We don't just live; we thrive!
