Sunday's Reflection

Today we celebrate the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Here are some of St. Francis de Sales thoughts on the Eucharist.

So that we might intimately be united with God's goodness, Jesus instituted the sacrament of the Eucharist. Our Savior desires us to be united to Him by a union so strong and close that we are marked with His features. In receiving the Eucharist our Lord carries us and does in us works altogether performed by Him. Whoever turns to the Eucharist frequently, and in a holy manner, builds up his or her spiritual health. If fruits that are tender and most subject to decay, such as strawberries, can easily be preserved a whole year in sugar and honey, it is no wonder that our hearts, no matter how frail and weak, are preserved by the spiritually real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.


After you have received our Lord in the Eucharist, talk with Him about your inmost concerns. Reflect that He is within

you and has come there for your happiness. Make Him as welcome as you possibly can. Conduct yourself in such a manner that by your actions all may know that God is with you.

Receive the Eucharist often. Two kinds of people ought to receive the Eucharist often: the strong and the weak. The strong, lest they become weak, and the weak that they may become strong. The sick that they may be cured, those in good health, that they may not fall sick. Persons who are involved in many worldly affairs need it. Those who labor much and are heavily burdened need to eat solid food and often.

In the Eucharist our Savior advances, strengthens and nourishes us with His self-giving love. Since Christ gives Himself totally to us in this Divine Sacrament, ought we not to give ourselves totally to Him, who is at once both Gift and Giver?

Reflexión del domingo

Enfasis Sugerido

"Hagan esto en mi memoria"

Perspectiva Salesiana

La Eucaristía – una palabra que literalmente significa dar gracias – es la celebración central de la comunidad Cristiana. Habla cantidades de quien es Dios en nuestras vidas. Habla cantidades de quienes somos y quienes hemos sido llamados a ser en las vidas de los demás.

La Eucaristía es el Corazón de nuestra fe.

La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que Dios nos ama tanto que envió a Jesús para que fuera nuestro redentor. La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que Dios nos ama tanto que permitió que el cuerpo de Jesús fuera maltratado y que la sangre de Jesús fuera derramada por nosotros. La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que Dios nos ama tanto que el Espíritu elevó a Jesús de entre los muertos para que nosotros pudiéramos compartir el poder y la promesa de la vida eterna.

La Oración Eucarística para los Niños III lo dice de la siguiente manera: Jesús "nos trajo las buenas nuevas de la vida que espera por nosotros en el cielo. El nos mostró

el camino hacia esa vida acá en la tierra; el camino del amor... El ahora nos reúne en una mesa y nos pide que hagamos lo que él hizo." La Oración Eucarística para la Reconciliación II nos dice que Jesús "nos ha confiado esta promesa de su amor".

La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que hemos sido llamados a hacer mucho más que simplemente recibir el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo: La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que cada uno de nosotros somos –que debemos ser– el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo para los demás. La Eucaristía celebra la verdad de que estamos llamados a permitir ser maltratados y derramados por los demás, a que vivamos nuestras vidas luchando por la justicia, la paz, la reconciliación, la sanación, la libertad, la vida y el amor.

Estamos llamados a proclamar la muerte del Señor en nuestra voluntad para ser el pan y el vino para los demás. Estamos llamados a proclamar la muerte del Señor –el poder del Señor– en nuestra voluntad para poner nuestras vidas, nuestros talentos y nuestros esfuerzos al servicio y la continuación de la redención, de la obra de salvación que Jesús inició.

Nosotros demostramos nuestra dignidad Eucarística y nuestro destino Eucarístico cuando acogemos el mandato de Jesús a que "hagamos esto en su memoria": no solo al celebrar la Eucaristía en el primer día de la semana, sino siendo la Eucaristía para los demás cada día de la semana, alimentando, nutriendo y perdonándonos los unos a los otros.

La Eucaristía no es simplemente algo que recibimos. La Eucaristía es algo en lo que nos debemos convertir. La Eucaristía es algo que debe ser compartido con los demás. La Eucaristía, en resumen, es un estilo de vida.

A cada nivel.

Seamos la Eucaristía los unos para los otros. Alimentemos, nutramos y perdonemos... en su memoria... en hermandad con los demás.





