The poker chips and charcoal were at 15 yards, the paper targets and paper cup at 25 yards.

Andrew McDonald joined us again. Andrew is a relatively new shooter who earned his Rifle Shooting Merit Badge at Scout Camp this summer, and has really taken a shine to shooting muzzleloaders. I think we will be seeing more good shooting from Andrew in the near future.
