### School Picture Days - August 17th and 18th

School Picture Day is a two-day event. Each student will have his/her individual picture taken. Middle School students will have their pictures retaken. Volunteers are needed to assist with class scheduling, order and payment collection, and assisting the photographer with preparing the students for their photos.

### Scholastic Book Fair - September 19th - 29th

The Scholastic Book Fair is a two-week event held in the CRS Cafeteria/Stage area. The first week is designated for stage set-up. Volunteers are needed to help transform the stage area into an exciting shopping environment consistent with the theme for the year. The books are also delivered from Scholastic during this week and volunteers are needed to unpack and display the books.

Volunteers are also needed to work the fair. The fair will be open to all student and families before and after-school, four mornings will be designated as "Donuts for Dad" before school (7:00- 8:45 am). Middle School Students will visit the fair on Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, and then all Elementary classes will visit the fair at a designated time during their school day the week of September 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>. This is one of the most popular CRPTO events of the year and several volunteers are needed!

## Health Screening – September 20th

Health Screening is a one-day event and an opportunity for volunteers to assist the school nurse with checking vision and hearing for our students. (Usually two-hour shifts.)

### Fall Carnival – October 21st (5:00 – 8:00 pm)

The Fall Carnival is an event that is fun for the whole family. It is held on a Friday evening on the CRS Elementary playground. The entire school staff, families and friends are invited to participate. Unlimited ride wristbands are available for all children ages 3 and up. There are carnival rides, bounce houses, games, prizes, a DJ and food. Each class is asked to collect donations for a themed basket, which are displayed and raffled at the Carnival. Volunteers are needed for assisting with the basket raffles, working the carnival games, selling wristbands, along with setup and cleanup. (Usually one-hour shifts)

## APEX Fun Run - January 17th - 27th

The Apex Fun Run Coaches start this event off on January 17th with a school wide pep rally. The students are sent home with instructions on how to collect pledges for running laps around the Apex course. The students usually run a maximum of 40 laps. The Fun Run takes place on Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are needed to assist with counting laps and water distribution. This is a fun day spent outdoors on our soccer fields. (Usually two hour shifts).

## Art and Garden Walk - March 22<sup>nd</sup> (5:00 - 7:00 pm)

The Art and Garden Walk is an evening for our parent community to appreciate our students' artwork, various musical groups and the CRS Gardens. Throughout the year, our Copper Ridge students take a science-based approach to gardening. They plant and maintain the garden throughout the school year and it is usually thriving by the time of this event. Volunteers are needed to display artwork throughout our campus and clean up after the event. (Usually 1 hour shifts throughout the school day to set-up)

## Copper Ridge Spring Dinner & Auction – April 7th (7:00 pm)

The Copper Ridge Spring Dinner and Auction will be an adult evening event for all parents and friends to attend. (No children please.) The event will include food, drinks, music, entertainment as well as auction items. This will be the most talked about event for 2017!! The event will need volunteers to help plan and organize an awesome evening as well as volunteers during the event.

## Teacher Appreciation Week - May 1st - 5th (Times vary)

Teach Appreciation Week is one of our favorite activities. Our main goal is to make EACH AND EVERY TEACHER feel special and appreciated. You will receive Sign-Up Genius invites for great opportunities to show your appreciation...morning coffee, lunches, etc.
