On May 16, JLDH had a change in Director and Assistant Director.

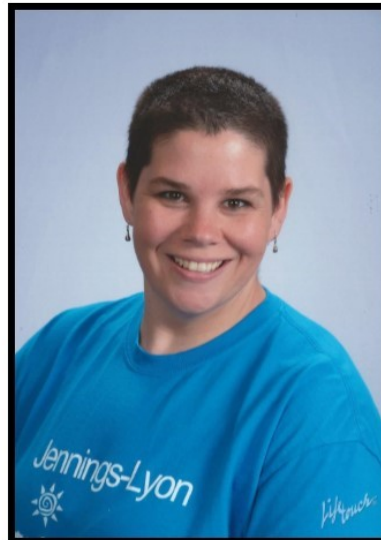

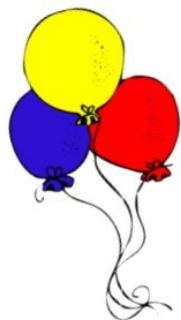
