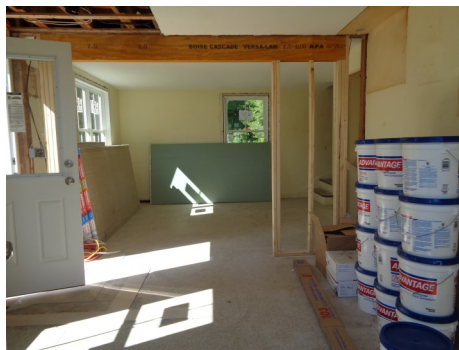

Clean Kids Challenge = Dominos Pizza: Whittier Falls Staff will resume housekeeping inspections in the newly renovated apartments. Kids can earn a \$15 Dominos gift card if both their bedroom and the kitchen area are neat and clean. It's easy! **Use the 1+2+3 method.**

Dover Fire Department Winter Safety Tips: Here are a few heating safety tips from the Dover Fire Department to keep you and your family safe this winter season: Keep anything that can burn at least three feet away from heating equipment, including portable space heaters. Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around space heaters. Never use your oven to heat your home.. Improper use of heating devices can lead to dangerous carbon monoxide buildup in your home. Do not tamper with your fire alarm or disconnect it. Call the Whittier Falls Office immediately if you need service with your smoke alarm.

Salted sand available: The city provides residents of Dover free salted sand, located at the intersection of Piscataqua and Drew Roads. Residents must bring their own supplies, such as buckets, bags and shovels. For more information, contact Community Services at 516-6450.
