Todd Bender was named the first Master Instructor for the National Skeet Shooting Association, has been trained by the UKs Clay Pigeon Shooting Association (CPSA) and is an Honorary Fellow in England's Institute of Clay Shooting Instructors. His teaching methods have taken him around the world and created a number of like world champions. Todd is recognized as the leading authority in shotgun shooting instruction. Todd helped develop the Wounded Warrior Day, a shooting event for active duty soldiers recovering from injuries sustained in action, and is the current Moving Target Shotgun Coach for the Elite Teams of the US Navy SEALs

In competition, Todd has maintained a position on top of the National Skeet Shooting Association for three decades. Over the years he has compiled 23 NSSA World Championships and been named to a record 33 consecutive Men's First All-American Teams. Todd is also the only shooter to record three consecutive back-to-back 550x550s at the World Championships in 2007, 2008 and 2009. Todd was inducted into the National Skeet Shooting Hall of Fame (1999), and in the same year was inducted into the first class of Trinity University's Athletic Hall of Fame.
