Since 1985, Costume Designer Randall Christensen of Randall Designs, has created and manufactured high-end glamour costumes for TV and film, as well as the Competitive Dance World; costuming top US and World Champions.

Currently the sole Costume Designer for ABC's hit show "Dancing With the Stars", he has been designing for the show since Season Two. His efforts awarded him an Emmy in 2006!

Randall has been nominated four times for a Costume Designers Guild Award.

He was recently seen on "The Rachael Ray Show" after challenging her to wear one of his creations!

Randall designed and created costumes for 2014 Winter Olympic Gold Medalists Meryl Davis and Charlie White, who have been clients for the past two Olympics.

He also designed/created costumes for Another 2014 Olympic competitors in Ice Dance representing Lithuania - Isabella Tobias and Deividas Stagniūnas.

Randall also contributed gowns for Jennifer Lopez in "Shall We Dance?", Mary Steenbergen in "Charm School", as well as for the movies "Take the Lead", "Dance With Me", and "So You Think You Can Dance?" and TLC Network's "Ballroom Bootcamp.

Randall has also designed for several Las Vegas projects as well as numerous Cruise Line shows!
